Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Boundary Modification Notice

The Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Program (State Superfund Program) is the State's program for identifying, investigating, and cleaning up sites where the disposal of hazardous waste may present a threat to public health and/or the environment. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) maintains a list of these sites in the Registry of Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites (Registry). The boundary of the class 4 site identified above, and located on the attached map, has been modified on the Registry for the following reason(s):

This is an administrative change. Historically, the site has been defined as a one-property parcel located at 200 Anderson Avenue. Because disposal and remediation has taken place on eight parcels of land, the site's boundary is being modified to include all or portions of the following parcels: 121.28-2-5, 15-17 Norwood St; 121.28-2-4, 183-185 Anderson Av; 107.77-1-28.1, 406 Atlantic Av (CSXT); 106.84-1-7, 190 Anderson Av; 106.84-1-6, 192-200 Anderson Av, (the original site parcel); 106.84-1-5, 220 Anderson Av; 106.84-1-4.002, 188 Anderson Av; 106.84-1-11, 360 N Goodman St.

Human exposures with residual contamination at the site parcels will continue to be addressed through compliance with the approved Site Management Plan to ensure that institutional and engineering controls remain in place and effective.
