### State Superfund Site Classification Notice

The Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Program is New York State's superfund program for identifying, investigating, and cleaning up sites where the disposal of hazardous waste may present a threat to public health and/or the environment. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) maintains a list of these sites in the Registry of Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites (Registry). The site identified above, and located on a map on the reverse side of this page, has been added to the Registry as a Class 2 site that presents a significant threat to public health and/or the environment for the following reason(s):

- Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) are present at the site in the shallow soils up to 260 parts per million (ppm) and up to 450 ppm in the deeper soils. These levels significantly exceed the hazardous waste threshold for PCBs in soil. Chlorinated solvents were also detected in the on-site soils at levels exceeding applicable soil cleanup objectives.
- People who enter the site could contact contaminants in the soil by walking on, digging, or otherwise disturbing the soil. Additional environmental investigations, including the collection of soil, groundwater, and soil vapor, on and off-site, are necessary to further evaluate the nature and extent of contamination and to better understand exposure pathways on and off-site.

DEC will keep you informed throughout the investigation and cleanup of the site.

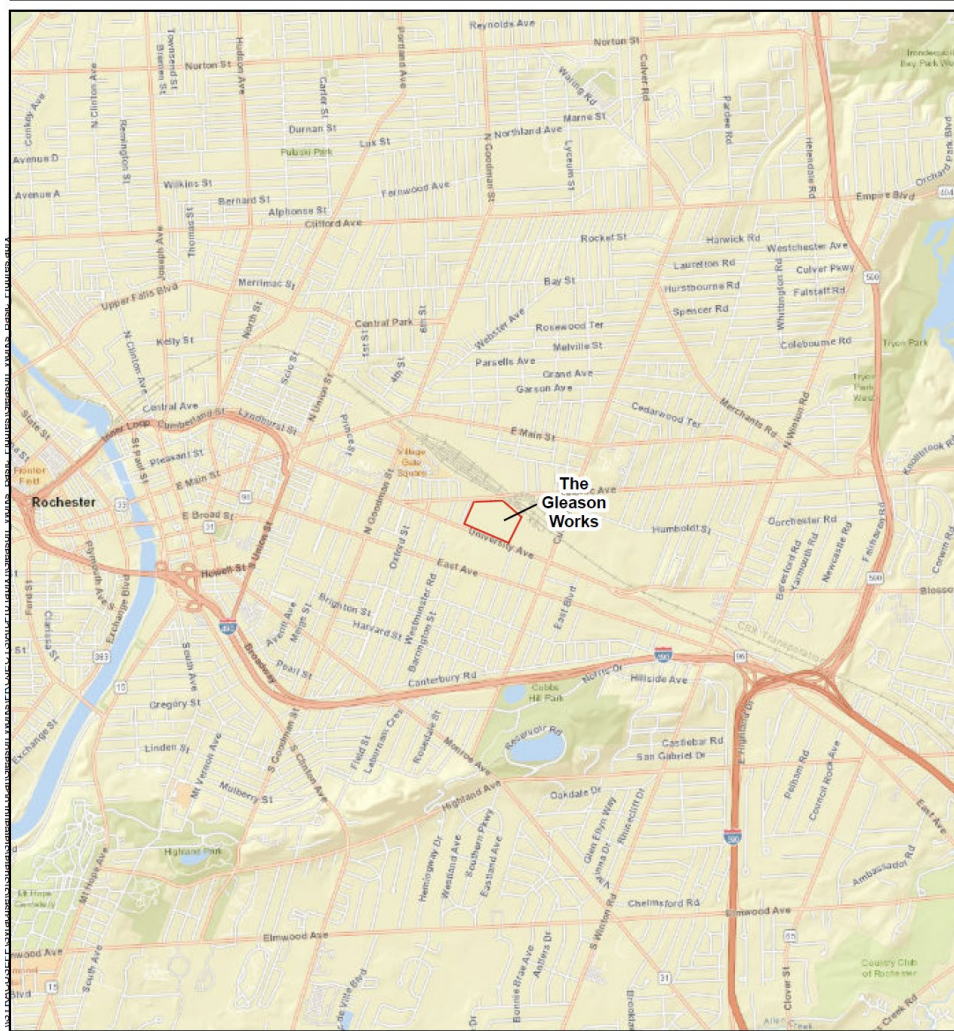

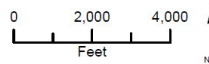

 Rochester, NY



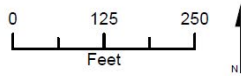
