PROJECT SUMMARY:
 As a result of past waste management operations, the on site soils and off site soils and sediments have been impacted by polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs).

TENTATIVE DETERMINATION: The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) is proposing the final remedy to address the contamination at the GE Buffalo Service Shop. The proposed corrective measures were selected because the Department has determined that when completed, the remedial activities will be protective of human health and the environment. The proposed final corrective measure by the Department includes the ICMS already undertaken by the facility, Alternative 2 - Remove and Replace Concrete Ramp, Complete Asphalt Overlay and Maintain Epoxy Coating and Asphalt described in the Focused Corrective Measures Study (CMS) Report dated July 13, 2011 and Alternative 4 - Surface and Subsurface Soil Excavation and Off Site Disposal described in the Revised CMS Final Report dated July 31, 2001. Changes to the proposed corrective measures or the selection of an alternative remedy may be made if public comments or additional data indicate that such changes would result in a more appropriate solution. After the public comment period has ended and comments have been reviewed and considered, the Department will select the Final Corrective Measures for the GE Buffalo Service Shop.

HOW TO PROVIDE YOUR COMMENTS: All comments will be considered when making the final decision for remedy that will address the site contamination. Upon approval of the final remedy, a response to any comments submitted will be issued which will describe and respond to the issues raised, and will identify any changes to the proposed Final Corrective Measures. A notice of the decision will be sent to each person who submits written comments or who requests such notice.

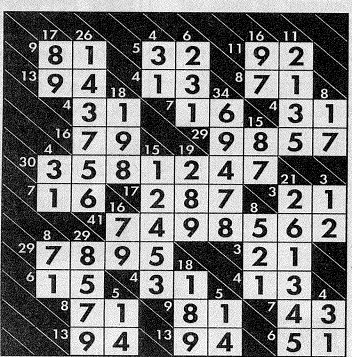

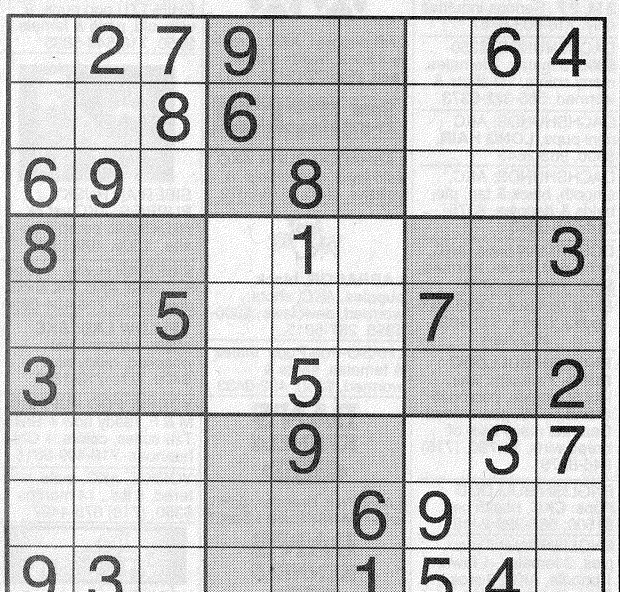


Sudoku Puzzle
