## DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

THIS DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS (the "Cred Restriction") is made this Tday of Jan., 200 l by CHARLES A. GAETANO (the "Owner"), the owner of property located between Railroad and Mill Streets in the City of Rome, County of Oneida, which was formerly owned by the General Cable Company (the "Site"). The Site was subdivided in an approval granted by the City of Rome Planning Board on April 1, 1997. This Deed Restriction relates to the following parcels in that subdivision: Parcel No. 4 (2.578 acres) ("Parcel No. 4 Property") and the parcels that make up the Railroad Street Property. The Railroad Street Property is comprised of the following three (3) parcels: Parcel No. 3 a/k/a "Bldgs 33/39 Property" - 1.458 acres located to the west of the Parcel No. 4 Property; Parcel No. 2 - 2.019 acres located to the north of the Parcel No. 4 Property; and Parcel No. 1 - 1.500 acres located to the northwest of the Parcel No. 4 Property. The Parcel No. 4 Property and the parcels that make up the Railroad Street Property are referred to hereunder as the "Northern Redevelopment Area." They are more fully described in the property description set forth in the attached Exhibit A.

### RECITALS

- 1. The Owner has entered into a Voluntary Remedial Agreement with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (the "Department") in the Matter of the Implementation of a Remedial Response for the Old General Cable Site a/k/a the Central Core of the East Rome Business Park (Index # D6-0001-97-01) (the "Order"). The Order became effective upon the signature of John P. Cahill, the Commissioner of the Department, on March 8, 1999.
- 2. The Owner has consented to the issuance of the Order for the purposes of addressing the environmental conditions at the Site (with the exception of the Roadway Parcel) so that it can be redeveloped and used for commercial and industrial purposes. The Order does not cover the portion of the Site known as the Roadway Parcel, because that parcel was conveyed by the Owner to the City of Rome on May 6, 1997.
- 3. There are three (3) separate Remedial Work Plans for areas of the Site that are described in the Order, including one for the Northern Redevelopment Area. The Remedial Work Plan for the Northern Redevelopment Area is attached as Exhibit C to the Order.
- 4. Upon the completion of the remedial activities described in the Remedial Work Plan for the Northern Redevelopment Area, the Owner is to submit for the Department's approval a Closure Report, summarizing the work. Jack Eisenbach Engineering, P.C. ("JEE"), on behalf of the Owner, submitted a Closure Report to the Department for the Northern Redevelopment Area on July 27, 2000.

5. By its letter dated [to be inserted], the Department approved JEE's Closure Report. Under subparagraph XI.A of the Order, the Owner is required to file a deed restriction covering the Northern Redevelopment Area within 30 days of his receipt of the Department's written approval of the Northern Redevelopment Area Closure Report. This Deed Restriction is being filed to comply with this requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Owner, intending to be legally bound, and in consideration of good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby declare as follows:

### 1. Use Restriction.

- (a) Each of the parcels in the Northern Redevelopment Area are hereby prohibited from ever being used for purposes other than for commercial or industrial use without the express written waiver of such prohibition by the Department, or if at such time the Department shall no longer exist, any New York State department, bureau, or other entity replacing the Department, respecting the parcel in question.
- (b) The groundwater underlying the parcels in the Northern Redevelopment Area shall not be used unless the user first obtains permission to do so from the Department, or if at such time the Department shall no longer exist, any New York State department, bureau, or other entity replacing the Department.

### 2. Enforcement.

- (a) The Owner, on behalf of himself and his heirs, successors, and assigns, hereby consents to the enforcement by the Department, or if at such time the Department shall no longer exist, any New York State department, bureau, or other entity replacing the Department, of the prohibitions and restrictions set forth in this Deed Restriction and hereby covenants not to contest such enforcement.
- (b) This Deed Restriction shall be deemed a covenant running with the land and an encumbrance on the fee simple title to the parcels that make up the Northern Redevelopment Area. It shall be binding on the Owner, his heirs, successors and assigns and all others claiming by them.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned has signed this Deed Restriction to comply with Subparagraph XI.A of the Order.
