Bill here are all the submittals I have from Op-Tech thus far,

The two submittals that we don't have yet that are the HASP and some documentation from the WWTP that they will accept the water after Op-Tech treats it.

I have reviewed the SWPPP (and Op-Tech incorporated most of my suggestions), the Construction Plan (it looked pretty good, had no changes) and the backfill document (I'm ok with it. As we discussed the percent passing the #80 sieve was 11% not <=10%, but we would like to use this if at all possible)  
The other documents I have not had a chance to review yet but I will.

Please let me know if there is anything that the DEC feels is not acceptable within these documents.
