1. SAWCUT AND REMOVE EXISTING ASPHALT PATH AS NECESSARY FOR TRENCH INSTALLATION. REPLACE WITH MINIMUM 6" SUBBASE STONE, 3" TYPE 3 ASPHALT BINDER AND 1" TYPE 7F TOP.
  2. REMOVE AND STORE EXISTING TREES AS NECESSARY. REPLACE AT LOCATIONS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER FOLLOWING TRENCH INSTALLATION.
  3. CONTRACTOR SHALL CAREFULLY REMOVE AND STORE EXISTING COVER AND TOPSOIL MATERIAL WHEN EXCAVATING FOR TRENCH. INTERIOR TRENCH WALLS SHALL BE PROTECTED FOR USE AS BACKFILL OVER THE TRENCH. ALL FILL MATERIAL ENCOUNTERED BENEATH THE EXISTING COVER SHALL BE CHARACTERIZED AND PROPERLY DISPOSED OF OFF-SITE.

  5. INSTALL TIE AND 5' LATERAL
