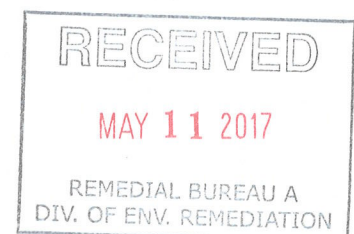

Tasks Initiated or Completed

- The AAR and information compiled by the Town, Northrop Grumman Systems, the United States Navy, and their consultants are under review by the Town.
- In a letter dated May 1, 2017, the Town sent a request to Mr. Steven Scharf at the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) for additional time to evaluate the current status of the ongoing remedial efforts at Bethpage Community Park and requested an extension of time to finalize the AAR.

Tasks to be Initiated or Completed during the Next Reporting Period

- After receiving a response from the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) Environmental Information Management System (EIMS) Manager regarding the TICs not included in the current NYSDEC Valid Values list, the finalized soil vapor EDD will be checked with the EQulS Electronic Data Processor (EDP). After the EDD pass through the EQulS EDP with no errors, the revised RI EDD containing soil vapor data will be submitted to the NYSDEC EIMS Administrator.
- Following finalization of the AAR, the updated version of the AAR will be submitted to the NYSDEC for review and approval.
