2. REQUIRED: Please provide a brief narrative describing the specific requests included in this amendment: On February 2, 2024, the 7 Lots which made up the BCP Site were reapportioned. The Site original consisted of Block 438, Lots 1, 2, 3 and Block 445, Lots 8 and 50. A BCA Amendment dated March 23, 2018 added Block 445, Lots 11 and 20 to the BCP Site. The total acreage of the BCP Site was recorded as being 2.118. Please See Exhibit A: Former BCP Site. The BCP Site still has the same boundary, however, it is now made up of only 3 lots known as follows; 325 Bond Street, Tax ID 3-438-1, 0.72 acres; 395 Carroll Street, Tax ID 3-445-11, 0.99 acres; and President Plaza, Tax ID 3-445-50, 0.41 acres. Please See Exhibit B: Full Site Current Tax Map, Lot 1 Current Tax Map and Lot 11 and 50 Current Tax Map. The Site is the same size, however, to be more accurate, the acreage of the BCP Site is 2.12.
