REQUIRED: Please provide a brief narrative describing the specific requests included in this amendment: The Volunteer seeks to modify the BCP Site's Section/Block/Lot (SBL) designation following a lot merger approved by the New York City Department of Finance (NYC DOF) and a subsequent update of the New York City Tax Map. An RP-602 Lot Merger Application was submitted to the NYC DOF to merge Block 574, Lots 1, 30, and 31 on May 16, 2025. These lots have now been merged into one lot: Block 574, Lot 1. The BCP Site Boundary has not changed. The Volunteer seeks to amend the BCA for the Site to reflect the Lot merger. A Site Location Map showing the BCP Site Boundary is provided as Figure 1. The NYC DOF Lot Merger Application (RP-602) and a copy of the NYC Tax Map showing the merger of Lots 1, 30, and 31 is included in Attachment A.

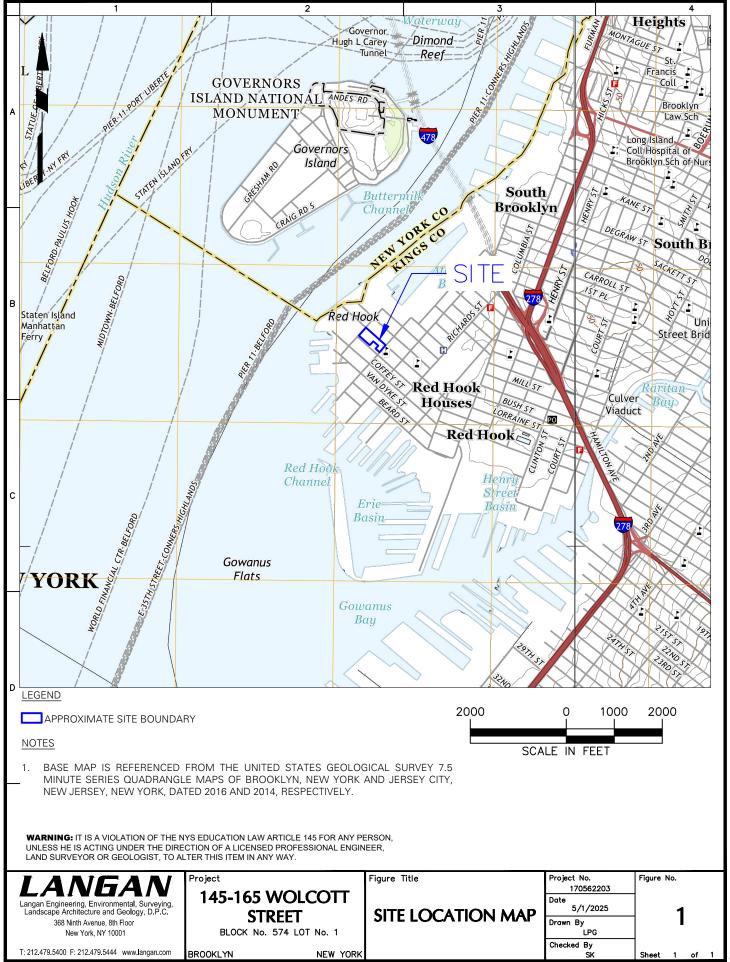

ALTERATION ON EXISTING BUILDINGS AND VACANT LAND:

- Completed application for Mergers or Apportionments.
- A Department of Buildings approved Subdivision of Improved (SI) as per DOF Operations Policy and Procedure Memorandum July 1, 2019.
 - Survey for alteration on existing building.
- Outstanding taxes, charges or tax liens for prior tax years must be satisfied.
