The Applicant seeks to update the BCP site description. The BCP site, previously identified as portions of Lot 22, was recently subdivided into new tax lots. Building 1 is identified as Block 3770, Lot 22. Building 2 is identified as Block 3770, Lot 100.
Figures 1 and 2 depict the updated site description.
The project will be an affordable housing project, but there is no agreement yet with the NYC Housing Preservation & Development (HDP). Remeeder Houses Housing Development Fund Company (site owner affiliated with the Requestor) is a Housing Development Fund Company (HFDC), and the housing produced will be required to be income restricted. Documentation as an affordable housing project will be provided, when available, prior to issuance of the CoC.

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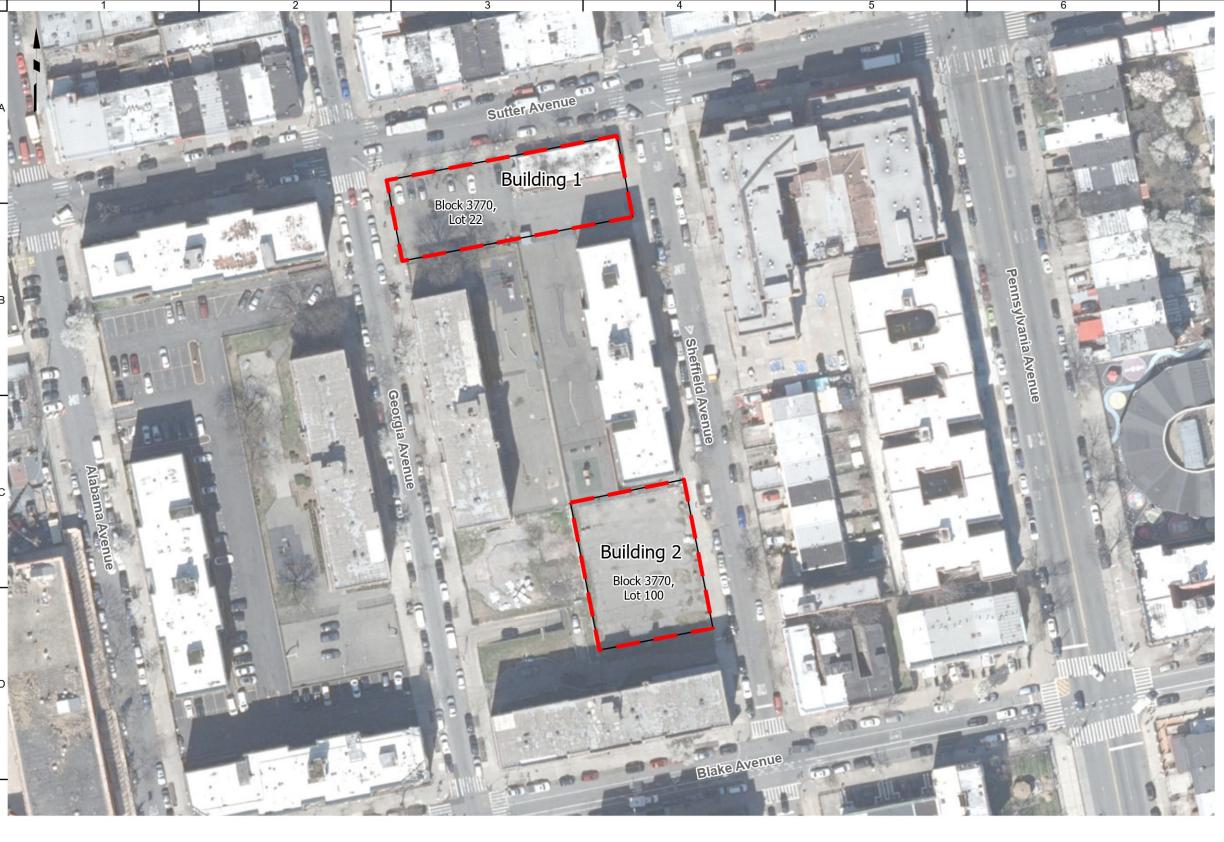
