Dear Mr. MacNeal:

This letter documents ongoing compliance with the Site Management Plan (SMP) prepared in July, 2006 in accordance with the New York State Brownfields Cleanup Program (BCP), for the properties located between West 41st Street and West 42nd Street and 11th and 12th Avenues on the west side of Manhattan, New York (the Site). Construction activities have already been completed at one of the two portions of the Site (River Place I) and construction activities are currently ongoing at the second portion of the Site (River Place II). The following is an update on the status of Institutional Control/Engineering Controls (IC/EC) implemented or planned to be implemented at the Site:

Cover System

The cover system planned for the Site includes the building foundation slabs, asphalt parking lots, concrete walkways, and top soil used for landscaping. This system is constantly improved as construction at the site continues and we will perform inspections of this system. We anticipate that essentially all the cover system outside the building envelopes will be available for inspection by December 2008. We will advise you of any schedule changes.

Inspection of Vapor/Water Barrier

The vapor/water-proofing barrier installation at River Place II was completed in October 2007 and a report documenting the installation was recently provided to NYSDEC. We will inspect the basement and sub cellar areas of River Place II in conjunction with the schedule for the December 2008 inspection of the cover system.

• Indoor Air Monitoring

The SMP requires indoor air sampling in River Place I during the heating season (November through March). We will conduct indoor air sampling in December 2008 in conjunction with the inspection of the Engineering Controls.

Groundwater Monitoring

The groundwater monitoring network planned for the Site can not be installed until access to the construction lay down area at River Place II is accessible. At that time the monitoring wells will be installed and sampled as described in the SMP. We anticipate that a groundwater monitoring report will be available for your review approximately 45 days after the monitoring network is completed. We anticipate being able to install the monitoring wells in May, 2009.

Institutional Controls - Environmental Easement

Groundwater is not used for any purpose. Land use remains as multi-story residential. The SMP is being implemented in accordance with the schedules discussed above.
