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1.0 INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW OF THE CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), in cooperation with the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) and the Volunteer (13th and 14th Street Realty, LLC.), is committed to informing and involving the public concerning the Investigation and Remediation of the Club East Site under the New York State Brownfield Cleanup Program.

On October 7, 2003, Governor George Pataki signed into law comprehensive legislation creating a new Brownfield Cleanup Program (BCP), modeled after the NYSDEC administrative Voluntary Cleanup Program. On November 18, 2005, the volunteer entered into a Brownfield Cleanup Program Agreement with the NYSDEC.

The Citizen Participation (CP) Plan identifies informational needs that relate to the Club East Site. In addition, it identifies information that NYSDEC needs from the community. The CP Plan also describes CP activities conducted to date and expected in the future during the investigation and remediation. The CP activities are designed to achieve the following objectives:

- Help the interested and affected public to understand the contamination problems at the Club East Site, and the nature and progress of NYSDEC's program to investigate and clean up the Site;
- Ensure open communication between the public and project staff throughout the remedial process;
- Create opportunities for the public to contribute information, opinions and perspectives that have potential to influence decisions about the Site's investigation and cleanup.

2.0 SITE BACKGROUND

The Site is located at 421-433 East 13th Street and 420 East 14th Street, along the north side of E. 13th Street and the south side of E. 14th Street between First Avenue and Avenue A. The Property consists of approximately 16,827 square feet of land occupied by adjoining one-story, two-story and three-story buildings. East Side Lumber, Personal Touch Valet, LaChapelle Photo Studio, White Express Cleaning and a vacant occupied the buildings until September 30, 2005. A Site Location Map (USGS Topographic Quadrangle is attached as Figure 1.

The site buildings comprise most of the Property and were built between 1903 and 1920. Previous occupants include a church, wagon builder, and a dry cleaning facility. The 1944 through 1996 Sanborn Maps show that the 431-433 13th Street part of the Site (easternmost) was occupied by the New York City Department of Sanitation for wood and oil storage. The building located at 427 E13th Street (middle of the Property) was utilized as a dry cleaning facility. The dry cleaning equipment was located on the first floor and the full basement was utilized for storage purposes. The cleaner had a self-contained laundry machine, which used perchloroethylene (PCE) and historically stored drums of waste PCE in the "Rear Yard". A Site Plan is included as Figure 2. The Property is connected to municipal water and sewer services and reportedly has been since development. There are no known active potable water supply wells within 1 mile of the Property.

Testing to date includes a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment and a two Phase II Environmental Investigations that have identified the presence of PCE and its chemical breakdown byproducts at concentration levels above applicable regulatory guidelines within the soil and groundwater.



3.0 PROJECT DESCRIPTION

13th and 14th Street Realty, LLC has entered into a Brownfield Cleanup Agreement with the NYSDEC as a Volunteer. Under the Brownfield Cleanup Program, 13th and 14th Street Realty, LLC plans to transform the hundred-year-old buildings into a new residential building with retail shops while conducting an accelerated remediation of the subsurface contamination. The residential building will total 100,000 square foot and will include 2,500 square feet of new retail space fronting E 14th Street. It is anticipated that 300-350 jobs will be created during the construction phase and 50 new jobs will be created upon project completion.

4.0 CITIZEN PARTICIPATION ACTIVITIES

This section of the CP Plan describes the CP activities to be conducted during the investigation and remediation activities at the Club East Site.

CP activities for this site include:

- Establishment of Document Repositories.
- Creation of a mailing list for the Potentially Affected/Interested Public. Individuals and groups included in the Contact List (see Section 7.0 of this Plan) are to receive all mailings. The list will be updated as needed.
- Identification of the NYSDEC and NYSDOH Project Managers for the project and the ways for the public to contact them. Interested persons are encouraged to contact staff at any time with additional issues or information needs.
- Publication of a Notice of Application to the BCP Program in The Villager (run 7/20/05) and Town and Village Real Estate Weekly (run 7/30/05).
- Mailing an "Interim Remedial Measure (IRM) Available for Public Comment" Fact Sheet to the Public Contact List.
- Administering a 30-day public comment period on the Remedial Investigation Work Plan.
 Following the public comment period, the NYSDEC may make revisions to the Work Plan if any new information is received regarding the proposed investigation/remediation.
- Mailing a Fact Sheet before approval of the Remedial Investigation (RI) Report.
- Mailing a Fact Sheet advising public of the Draft Remedial Action Work Plan, and a 45 public comment period concerning same.
- Mailing a "Start of Construction" Fact Sheet.
- Mailing of Fact Sheet advising that Remedial Action is complete, and that the Remedial Action Report is under review.
- Notice and mailing of Fact Sheet within 10 days of signing "Certificate of Completion" (when institutional/engineering controls are used).
