1. Introduction

In accordance with the reporting requirements of the Brownfield Cleanup Agreement (BCA) for the above-referenced site, Langan Engineering, Environmental, Surveying, Landscape Architecture and Geology, D.P.C. (Langan) has prepared this monthly progress report to summarize the work performed at the Kasser Scrap Metal and Rector Cleaners Site (site) from March 1 – March 31, 2025.

The site is located at 111 Washington Street in the Financial District of New York, New York and is identified as Block 53, Lot 12 on the Manhattan Borough Tax Map. The site is about 11,255 square feet and is an active construction site.

2. Investigation or Remedial Actions Relative to the Site during This Reporting Period

The Volunteer continued implementing the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC)-approved Remedial Action Work Plan (RAWP). Activities during this reporting period included:

 On April 3, 2025, Urban disposed of four 55-gallon drums containing drilling spoils from the installation of post-remediation groundwater monitoring wells (LMW-01 through LMW-04) to the Clean Earth of North Jersey (CENJ) facility located in Kearny, NJ.

On March 4, 2025, Langan reviewed the results of the four post-remediation groundwater sampling events with the NYSDEC.

3. Actions Relative to the Site Anticipated for the Next Reporting Period

Langan plans to continue revising the draft Final Engineering Report (FER) and draft Site Management Plan (SMP) and may submit the documents to the NYSDEC pending receipt of asbuilt documentation, drawings, and other supporting information from Urban and Consigli.
