1. Introduction

In accordance with the reporting requirements of the Brownfield Cleanup Agreement (BCA) for the above-referenced site, Langan Engineering, Environmental, Surveying, Landscape Architecture and Geology, D.P.C. (Langan) has prepared this monthly progress report to summarize the work performed at The Beacon (site) during July 2026.

The approximately 35,000-square-foot (0.80-acre) site is located at 413 East 120th Street in the East Harlem neighborhood of Manhattan, New York and is identified as Tax Block 1808, Lot 8 on the Manhattan Borough Tax Map. The site is developed with a 6-story former school building used for offices and community services, and an asphalt parking lot. The building has an area of about 18,300 square feet and has a full cellar.

2. Investigation or Remedial Actions Relative to the Site during This Reporting Period

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) provided comments to the October 9, 2025 draft Remedial Investigation Report (RIR) on July 30, 2026. Langan began addressing the comments received.

Langan awaited comments from the NYSDEC on the draft Remedial Action Work Plan (RAWP), which was submitted on January 12, 2026. Although review comments have not been issued, NYSDEC has committed to RAWP approval and Decision Document issuance in the Fall of 2026 to satisfy a Housing Preservation and Development (HPD) loan requirement.

3. Actions Relative to the Site Anticipated for the Next Reporting Period

Langan will submit the revised draft RIR and the Waste Characterization Report to the NYSDEC and will await comments from the NYSDEC on the draft RAWP.
