## **Property Description Narrative**

The Site is located at 129-09 Jamaica Avenue, Richmond Hill, New York 11418. The building was formerly owned and operated by Ideal Vortex Laundry, which utilized a petroleum dry cleaning machine during the 1930's through 1950's. Uniforms for Industry (UFI) acquired the property in the 1950's and continued laundry operations through November 2002, when all operations were ceased.

The Site consists of an approximately 1.72-acre irregular-shaped parcel of land and is developed with two (2) interconnected one (1)- to two (2)-story vacant industrial buildings, located on the central and southeastern portions of the Site, respectively. The onsite facility, constructed of brick, steel, wood, and concrete in 1929, with a series of additions in the 1950s and the 1960s, with the last addition constructed in the 1990s, occupies approximately sixty-five percent (65%) of the Site.

Ten (10) underground storage tanks (USTs) were historically located on the Site as follows: one (1) 10,000-gallon No. 6 fuel oil UST; three (3) 2,000-gallon mineral spirit USTs; one (1) 7,500-gallon mop oil UST; one (1) 6,000-gallon No. 2 fuel oil UST; one (1) 6,000-gallon mop oil UST; and three (3) 2,000-gallon mineral oil USTs. During the 2003 removal of the underground tanks located throughout the property, suspect impacted soils were identified.

On February 17-18 and March 26, 2004, VERTEX installed four (4) groundwater monitoring wells at the Site. The Additional Subsurface Investigation performed by GC Environmental in August 2005 included twelve (12) soil borings and the installation of eight (8) groundwater monitoring wells. The main results of these investigations are as follows:

- Soil contamination includes compounds associated with petroleum products, as
  well as chlorinated organic compounds. Petroleum contamination present in the
  soil is believed to originate with leaking fuel oil and mop oil underground storage
  tanks, which have been removed. The likely source of chlorinated solvents is
  from spills and/or discharges over time from historical operations at the Site and
  from potentially offsite sources.
- Concentrations of petroleum compounds in soil vary widely in the areas sampled, and appear to be concentrated in the general area of two specific borings, B-1 and B-2, where total VOCs range from 11,121 micrograms per kilogram (µg/Kg) in soil boring B-1 to 181,400 µg/Kg in soil boring B-2.
- Groundwater contamination is highest in MW-8, where separate-phase free product has also been observed. Contamination includes significant levels of petroleum compounds, as well as chlorinated solvent compounds. Total volatile organic compounds (TVOC) range from 11 micrograms per liter (μg/L) in MW-12 to 281,2000 μg/L in MW-8 (free product sample). The next highest TVOC concentration was detected in MW-1 (11,887 μg/L).

- Separate-phase free product has been observed in up to four onsite monitoring wells at measured thicknesses up to 6 feet (MW-8). Based on multiple water level gauging rounds, it does not appear that the free product plume is migrating offsite.
- The extent of chlorinated solvent and petroleum contamination throughout the Site is most likely associated with releases over an extended period of time from dry cleaning operations and leaking USTs onsite into the soil, and potentially from offsite sources.

# APPENDIX B

Project Description

#### **Project Description**

This Site is currently vacant (building structures are present) and impacted soil and groundwater have been discovered during recent investigation activities. The project involves completing the investigation and remediation of soil and groundwater impacts, including work required to address NYSDEC spill numbers 05-07800 and 02-08119. The Volunteer plans on redeveloping this property as a mix of commercial and low-income housing as part of community revitalization. More specifically, the proposed development consists at this stage of a seven-story building that fronts on Jamaica Avenue, partitioned into retail, residential, and community space at street level and residential units on all remaining floors. The rear (north) of the Site is proposed to be divided into a parking lot (circa 65 parking spaces) and outdoor space (see following page for conceptual model).

A key aspect of this project will be the completion of a true "brown to green" redevelopment. The Volunteer's consultant, Roux Associates, Inc., in addition to DOMANI Sustainability Consulting, LLC (a subsidiary of Roux Associates), will complete investigation and remediation activities, and ultimately assist in the design and implementation of green building and sustainable land use practices.

# APPENDIX E

Proximity to Real Property

According to the Zoning Ordinance of the City of New York and based on Roux Associates' visual inspection, the surrounding area is utilized for industrial, commercial, educational, transportation, and residential purposes.

To the north of the Site are residential properties, a portion of the Long Island Rail Road, Primary Electrical Supply, Regency Collision Co. and Hillside Avenue, beyond which are CVS Pharmacy, Hillside Car Wash and Express Lube Detailing Center, Mystic Wholesale Motors, a Getty gasoline service station, and additional commercial properties, including French Cleaners, a dry cleaning establishment, and residential properties.

To the east of the Site is a portion of the Long Island Rail Road, beyond which are residential properties, 130<sup>th</sup> Street, and commercial properties.

To the south of the Site is Jamaica Avenue, beyond which is the New York City Transit Authority (NYCTA) 129<sup>th</sup> Street Yard and additional commercial and residential properties.

To the west of the Site is 127<sup>th</sup> Street, beyond which is Los Amigos restaurant, Paris Flowers and Party Goods, and additional commercial, residential, and educational properties.

# APPENDIX F

Potential Vulnerability of Groundwater to Contamination

Potable water in the area of the Site is provided by the municipal system from upstate reservoirs. Groundwater contamination has been identified at the Site. There are no known wellhead protection or groundwater recharge areas in the area of the Site.

# APPENDIX G

Geography and Geology of the Site

According to the US Geological Survey (USGS) Topographic Map of Jamaica, New York Quadrangle, USGS, dated 1966, photorevised 1979, the Site's elevation is approximately 60 feet above mean sea level. Topographically, the Site is level with no abrupt changes in elevation. The topography in the vicinity of the Site slopes gently to the south towards Jamaica Bay, located approximately 4 miles to the south of the Site.

According to the Hydrogeologic Framework of Long Island, New York, USGS, 1989, the geology in the area of the Site consists of approximately 150 feet of glacial deposits composed of clay, sand, gravel, and boulders, which form the Upper Glacial Aquifer, underlain by approximately 125 feet of sand, clay, and gravel, which form the Magothy Aquifer. The Magothy Aquifer is underlain by approximately 180 feet of clay, which form the Raritan Confining Unit, underlain by approximately 195 feet of sand and gravel, which form the Lloyd Aquifer. The bedrock in the area of the Site consists of crystalline metamorphic and igneous rocks and is approximately 650 feet below grade.

Based on the information gathered during site investigation activities, the geology of the Site to the sampled depth of approximately 50 feet below grade consists of dense, browngray, fine-coarse sand with some fine-coarse gravel and occasional cobbles and small boulders.

Based on the results of monitoring well survey and groundwater level measurement, groundwater flow direction at the Site is to the southwest. Depth to groundwater below the Site is approximately 40 feet below grade. The water table is rather flat, but forms a small groundwater mound in the vicinity of Monitoring Well MW-1.
