CERTIFICATE OF CLEANING

The following Tanks or Vessels have been cleaned in accordance with RCRA Clean Standards, which states that pipes and apparatus "can" contain residual dust (on exterior) when being sent to the recycling facility as "Processed scrap metal". Pipes or tanks + vessels that have product inside need to follow the guidelines below using the definition of RCRA clean.

RCRA Clean = According to federal regulations, a container is considered empty when all wastes are removed using common practices and:

1. There must be no more than 2.5 cm (1 inch) remaining in the container. -- or --
2. containers less than 110 gallons must have no more than 3% remaining. -- or --
3. containers over 110 gallons must have no more than 0.3% remaining in the container
4. Compressed gas cylinders are considered empty when the pressure in the container approaches atmospheric pressure.
5. Containers holding acutely hazardous materials must be triple rinsed.

Scrap Clean Standard - Scrap metal that is disposed of or recycled is a solid waste; however, it is exempt from Subtitle C regulation when it is reclaimed (i.e., recycled to recover metal content). This does not apply to processed scrap metal, which is excluded from hazardous waste regulation entirely (as discussed in Chapter III, Hazardous Waste Identification).
