1. Introduction

In accordance with the reporting requirements of the 8 December 2016 Brownfield Site Cleanup Agreement (BCA) (as amended) for the above-referenced site, Langan Engineering, Environmental, Surveying, Landscape Architecture and Geology, D.P.C. (Langan) prepared this monthly progress report, on behalf of CP VIII LIC Owner, LLC (the Volunteer), to summarize the work performed at 43-30 24th Street, Long Island City, New York (the site) from August 1 to 31, 2023.

The site, Long Island City Center, consists of one trapezoidal-shaped lot (Queens Tax Map Block 436, Lot 1) encompassing approximately 58,600 square feet (±1.3 acres). The site was formerly improved by a two-story warehouse building and a one-story parking garage. The parking garage was demolished in August 2016 and the warehouse building was demolished in April 2017. The site is bound by a 5-story office building and a construction site followed by 43rd Avenue to the north, 23rd Street to the west, 44th Road to the south, and 24th Street to the east. The elevated New York City Transit Authority (NYCTA) No. 7 subway structure runs along 23rd Street. Land use within a half mile of the site is urbanized and includes residential, commercial and industrial buildings, cross streets, subway tunnels and elevated railways, government buildings, and school facilities.

2. Remedial Actions Relative to the Site during this Reporting Period

Langan continued implementing the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC)-approved Remedial Action Work Plan (RAWP) during the reporting period. The following were completed:

- The foundation contractor (ECD) and others continued constructing the above-grade building elements and off-site Con Edison vault.
- Langan continued drafting the Final Engineering Report (FER).

3. Actions Relative to the Site Anticipated for the Next Reporting Period

Langan will continue drafting the FER and will submit the report by October 1st.

NYSDEC provided comments on the easement package on September 7, 2023. The revised easement package will be submitted in the next reporting period.

4. Approved Activity Modifications (changes of work scope and/or schedule)

5. Results of Sampling, Testing and Other Relevant Data

No samples were collected during the reporting period.

6. Deliverables Submitted During This Reporting Period

7. Information Regarding Percentage of Completion
