#### Work Activities Performed:

PVE was retained by EFG/Saber Heritage SC, LLC for the ongoing investigation and remediation activities in accordance with the NYSDEC BCP requirements.

### Site Activities:

- Town of Poughkeepsie Water Department conducted excavation activities early May without PVE or Volunteer notice prior to the work. The excavation took place adjacent to the west auto garage (See Photo 3) within the Town of Poughkeepsie watermain easement. The Town is currently working on the installation and testing of a water maintenance loop in this area. The Town will notify PVE when backfilling activities to take place in June 2022. No excavation activities took place outside of the easement area. Approximately 3-4 yards of DOT ITEM #4 was imported to the site used as specified fill around the watermain. No onsite soils were removed from the subject property.
- On-site structures continue to deteriorate within the BCP boundary.

#### Waste Disposal:

No waste disposal was undertaken during site activities.

#### Problems Encountered:

Moderate deterioration of on-site structures.

Next BCP inspection scheduled for June 2022.
