



#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Purpose and Scope of Project

Redevelopment/Reuse plan for the property is as a full service drug store/retail establishment. Project will involve demolition of existing site structures, environmental site investigation and remediation and ultimately new construction with a total investment in excess of \$2,000,000.

Estimated completion, 2005.

#### LAND USE FACTORS

Item(s) 13 & 14:

The site and the surrounding properties are on public water supplies. One water supply source was identified within 1/2-mile of the site, to the west and upgradient. Previous investigations at the site have identified contaminants in groundwater samples taken from wells within the site boundary. The potential vulnerability of local groundwater to site contamination is reduced by the underlying clay lenses which can impede contaminant migration.

Item 15:

Site Geology: The surficial geology of the SITE consists primarily of a stratified glacial outwash sequence overlying lacustrine varved silt and clay deposits. Test boring data confirms the presence of granular outwash sand and varved deposits.
