A 0.1815-acre sloped portion of the 0.659 acres BCP Site located on a portion of 32 John Street and identified as "Upland Area #2" is being removed from the BCP Site. See Ex. A Old BCP Site Map. This portion of the Site is being removed because the land is subject to a permanent slope easement preventing future development. In addition, Phase I historical use investigations revealed no historical uses were present on this portion of the Site nor was there any environmental history for this sloped area which could have caused this land to be contaminated. The new acreage of the reduced Site is 0.4778 acres. A map depicting the new Site boundary is attached as Exhibit B. The reduction in the Site boundary will not effect the remediation efforts on the remaining portion of the BCP Site.

BCA Amendment - BCP Site Boundary Reduction

The attached Change of Use/BCA Amendment Application is being submitted to reduce the boundary of the BCP Site by 0.1815 acres. The Site is now a portion of 32 Johns Street and is 0.4778 acres. A copy of the survey showing the original BCP site boundary is attached as **Exhibit A** and a copy of the survey showing the new BCP site boundary is attached as **Exhibit B**. A revised tax map is attached as **Exhibit C**.

The Site is being reduced because the Applicant did not realize at the time of the Application that the property being removed is subject to a steep slope easement that does not allow development. As a result, this land has historically never been used for any purpose and therefore is not likely to be contaminated. This all became evident when it was not even possible to get sampling equipment onto that side of the Saw Mill River as a result of the presence of the River, the steep slope and extensive vegetation.

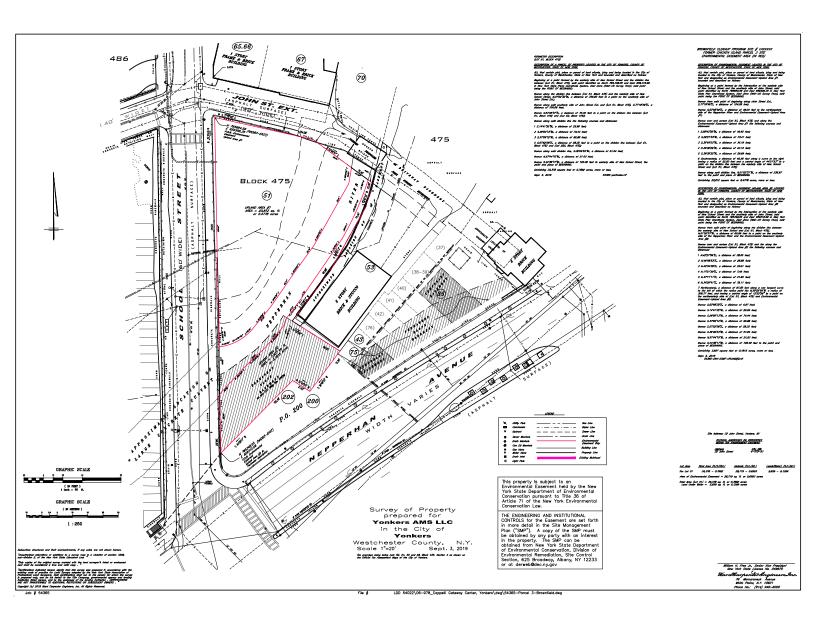

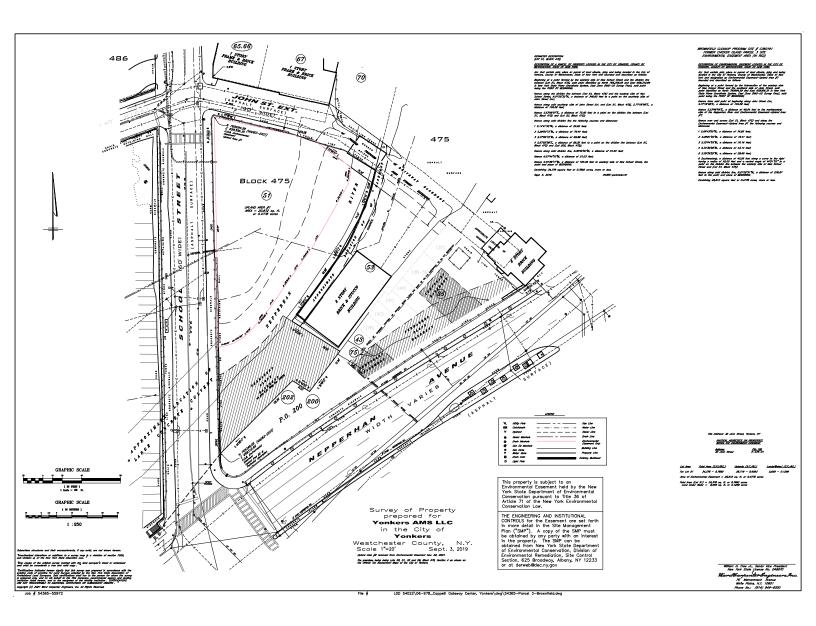

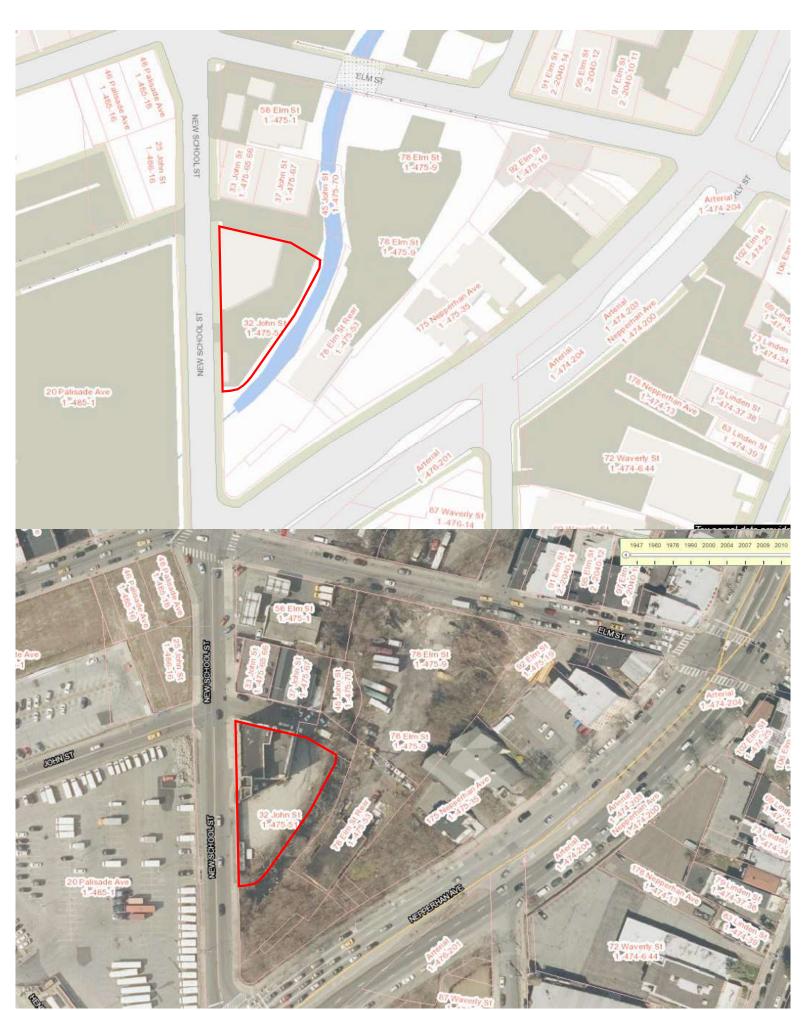
