"Upside down" shall mean a property where the projected and incurred cost of the investigation and remediation which is protective for the anticipated use of the property equals or exceeds seventy-five percent of its independent appraised value, as of the date of submission of the application for participation in the brownfield cleanup program, developed under the hypothetical condition that the property is not contaminated.

From 6 NYCRR 375-3.2(I) as of August 12, 2016 (Please note: Eligibility determination for the underutilized category can only be made at the time of application): 375-3.2:

- (I) "Underutilized" means, as of the date of application, real property on which no more than fifty percent of the permissible floor area of the building or buildings is certified by the applicant to have been used under the applicable base zoning for at least three years prior to the application, which zoning has been in effect for at least three years; and
 - (1) the proposed use is at least 75 percent for industrial uses: or
 - (2) at which:
 - (i) the proposed use is at least 75 percent for commercial or commercial and industrial uses:
 - (ii) the proposed development could not take place without substantial government assistance, as certified by the municipality in which the site is located; and
 - (iii) one or more of the following conditions exists, as certified by the applicant:
 - (a) property tax payments have been in arrears for at least five years immediately prior to the application;
 - (b) a building is presently condemned, or presently exhibits documented structural deficiencies, as certified by a professional engineer, which present a public health or safety hazard; or
 - (c) there are no structures.

"Substantial government assistance" shall mean a substantial loan, grant, land purchase subsidy, land purchase cost exemption or waiver, or tax credit, or some combination thereof, from a governmental entity.

SECTION I: PROPERTY INFORMATION

Property Description Narrative

Location

The Project Site is a 4.97-acre property comprised of six contiguous parcels (Tax Lots 1 through 5, and 30), located on the eastern side of Jarvis Street, the southern side of Clinton Street, and the western side of Hudson Street (almost 90% of the Site is occupied by Lot 2). See Figure 1 (Site Location Map), Figure 10 (Tax Map), and the table below.

Surrounding-area properties typically contain residential and small commercial uses. The Site is adjoined to the north by multiple residential, small commercial, and mixed-use buildings (residential and commercial) across Clinton Street, to the east by a mixed-use building on Clinton Street and residences across Hudson Street, to the south by railroad tracks, and to the west by a filling station and convenience store across Jarvis Street. An adjoining property containing a mixed use building is located on the southern side of Clinton Street between Site lots 30 and 2. Figure 11 (Property Ownership Map) identifies all 34 adjoining properties.

Site Features

Lot 30 at the northwestern corner (fronting Jarvis and Clinton Streets) contains a one-story office building; the remainder of the Site is vacant land containing foundation remnants of former large commercial buildings and overgrown areas. See Figure 2 (Site Map) for the layout of existing buildings and exterior areas, based on an Existing Conditions Plan (Delta Engineers, Architects, & Surveyors, April 2024).

Current Zoning and Land Use

All property lots are zoned "Neighborhood Commercial", with exception of Lot 5, which is zoned "Light & Medium Industrial". These designations allow for the planned mixed use (residential and small commercial) development. Adjoining uses include residential, mixed residential and commercial, and small commercial buildings, as well as railroad tracks. See Figure 3 (Zoning Map), Figure 9 (Development Plan), and Figure 11 (Property Ownership Map).

Past Uses of the Site

Historical property uses (documented as early as the 1880s) include a sleigh and wagon manufacturer (until the 1930s), a printer and book manufacturer (Vail Ballou Co.; 1910s to 1990s), a filling station (Lot 3; 1940s

and 1950s), numerous small commercial operations, and residential uses. Available records indicate that Lot 3 and 5 have been vacant since the 1950s and prior to 1970, respectively, the former Vail-Ballou manufacturing facility on Lot 2 (operations also extended to adjoining properties to the east) was demolished in stages in the mid to late 1990s, and the former structures on Lots 1 and 4 were demolished between 2018 and 2019. See also Section IV, Property's Environmental History. Former manufacturing (including printing), the former filling station (gasoline storage tanks and potential repair activities), are known potential sources of site contamination conditions.

Site Geology and Hydrogeology

Local area topography is generally somewhat hilly. Surface relief at and near the Site is relatively uniform, with overall gentle downward slopes to the east towards the Chenango River, located approximately 0.7 mile to the east. The Site has surface elevations generally in the range of 855 to 860 feet above sea level (see Figure 4). Soils encountered at the Site during environmental and geotechnical investigations (maximum boring depth of 50 feet below ground surface [bgs]) generally consisted of fill (sand, gravel, brick, cinders and ash) from the surface to as deep as approximately 13 feet bgs, underlain by native glacial outwash deposits (bedrock was not encountered). Groundwater was present between approximately 15 to 23 feet bgs, and direction of shallow groundwater flow was determined to be easterly. The Site is not in a flood hazard area (see Figure 5) and there are no surface waterbodies or wetlands on or near the Site (see Figures 6 and 7).

Environmental Assessment

Subsurface investigations at Lot 2 in 2001 documented petroleum contamination in soil, and soil sampling in 2023 and 2025 documented elevated levels of metals (arsenic, barium, lead, and mercury) and/or semi-volatile organic compounds (SVOCs) in soil (contamination likely related to former on-site commercial uses and/or impacts from building demolition). Widespread SVOC and heavy metals impacts present Site-wide have been documented at concentrations above NYSDEC Soil Cleanup Objectives (SCOs) for Restricted-Residential Use (RRU). Lead and several SVOCs are documented at concentrations over 30 times RRU SCOs, and arsenic is reported over 9 times the RRU (maximum 149 ppm) at sample locations corresponding with former on-site industrial uses including electroplating and printing. These findings indicate a significant potential exposure risk at the Site resulting from impacts associated with former industrial uses. Environmental conditions at the proposed BCP Site are presented in Section VI, and exceedances of RRU SCOs in soil are shown on Figure 8.

SECTION II: PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Purpose and Scope of the Project

The Requestor is seeking the acceptance of the proposed Site into the New York State Brownfield Cleanup Program (BCP). The purpose of the project is Site remediation to facilitate construction of a new building (see Figure 9, Development Plan). Site contamination exceeds RRU SCOs, and requires active remediation to accommodate the proposed Site use; the Site, therefore, qualifies as a Brownfield Site as defined at 6 NYCRR 375-1.2(b).

The Requestor is proposing to construct two new five-story residential buildings, with several small commercial spaces fronting Clinton Street. The tax credits available under the Brownfield Cleanup Program

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will make the project more economically feasible and result in substantial public benefits such as construction jobs and full-time employees, as well as facilitate the redevelopment of the area.

Green and Sustainable Remediation

NYSDEC DER-31 *Green Remediation* requires that Green and Sustainable Remediation (GSR) concepts and techniques be considered and/or implemented during all stages of the remedial program, with the goal of improving the sustainability of the cleanup and summarizing the net environmental benefit of any implemented green technology.

The following general goals, consistent with DER-31, are applicable at all stages of the BCP process (environmental investigation and remediation, and Site management as required):

- Reduce total energy use and increase the percentage of energy from renewable resources;
- Reduce air pollutants and greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions;
- Reduce water use and preserve water quality;
- Conserve material resources and reduce waste; and,
- Protect land and ecosystem services.

In support of these goals, best management practices will be implemented to minimize the environmental footprint of the investigation and remediation activities (to the extent feasible), including:

- Schedule fieldwork activities to minimize mobilization of equipment, personnel, and supplies;
- Plan fieldwork to efficiently manage use of equipment utilizing fuel/generating exhaust and water for decontamination activities, and minimize travel distances by using local contractors;
- Minimize waste generation through efficient material use, and re-use or recycling (as possible) of materials that could be considered wastes (e.g., use of drilling spoils for on-Site backfill); and,
- Conduct fieldwork such that soil compaction, soil erosion, and surface runoff are limited.

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GSR practices implemented at the Site will be documented in the Remedial Investigation Report (RIR) and the Final Engineering Report (FER), and in any required Periodic Review Report (PRR). GSR reporting will include a breakdown and summary of quantitative information (e.g., materials use, waste generation, etc.) obtained using an approved environmental footprint analysis calculator, such as the USEPA's SEFA (Spreadsheets for Environmental Footprint Analysis) or SiteWise™ from the Sustainable Remediation Forum (SURF).

If a Site management program is implemented, a Climate Screening Checklist will be completed to identify potential climate-change impacts on the project Site and the engineering controls; if the Climate Screening identifies potential impacts then a Climate Vulnerability Assessment will be performed, including an evaluation of measures to minimize the impact of potential identified vulnerabilities.

SECTION IV: LAND USE FACTORS

Zoning

Current zoning (Figure 3) is Neighborhood Commercial, with exception of Lot 5, which is zoned Light & Medium Industrial and where no residential development is planned.

Current and Anticipated Use

There are no active uses of the Site, which currently contains a vacant one-story commercial building on Lot 30 (205 Clinton Street, most recently occupied by an insurance agency), with the remains of former foundations and paved parking lots, as well as overgrown vacant land, present throughout all remaining areas (Figure 2). The structure on Lot 30 became vacant in 2022; there is no readily available information, however, for when previous site structures were vacated. Based on historical maps and other historical records, building demolition occurred between 1952 and 1970 at Lot 3 and Lot 5, the former manufacturing facility on Lot 2 was demolished in stages in the mid to late 1990s, and former structures on Lots 1 and 4 were demolished between 2018 and 2019.

Development plans for the Project Site include construction of a two, new five-story residential buildings (affordable housing) with partial basements and several small commercial (retail) uses fronting Clinton Street (Figure 9).

Compliance with Zoning Laws, Recent Development, and Community Master Plans

New construction will occur on the portion of the property zoned Neighborhood Commercial, which allows for the planned development, consistent with applicable bulk controls and existing City and State plans and policies. Zoning districts are shown on Figure 3.

The NPV report further references and describes findings from several earlier reports (not available for review and not provided in the Phase I ESA appendices), including:

- ESA, Enviro Testing, 1995;
- Additional Site Investigation Letter Report, GeoLogic, 2001; and,
- Phase I ESA and Direct Push Sampling Report, GeoLogic, 2008.

Note: These documents appear to have been intended to generally be inclusive of the former Vail-Ballou industrial facility in its entirety, comprised of Site Lot 2 as well as adjoining off-site locations; the following discussion describes relevant findings for the Site based on the available information.

According to NPV, the 1995 Enviro Testing report stated that:

Site inspection indicated there was a partially vacant 196,000-square foot industrial building, currently used for storage of computer supplies and an auto repair business...numerous drums, containers, temporary mixing vats, etc. still exist on site and some are corroded and leaking unknown materials...Vail-Ballou listed as storing developing chemicals, diazo solutions, activators, stabilizers and fixers, most of which are used in photo processing... evidence of possible Class V underground

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injection wells were identified inside the building and may be receiving waste (i.e. oils, gas, antifreeze) from the auto repair operation.

Based on the reported building size, as well as a 1995 aerial photograph reviewed by GBTS, this description likely includes one or more structures formerly located on Site Lot 2.

The 2000 Geologic Phase II ESA summarized installation of three borings near the former building(s) at Lot 2, soil sampling, conversion of three borings to groundwater monitoring wells, and groundwater sampling. No notable field evidence of contamination was observed during the fieldwork, and no significant contamination was reported in soil. Unfiltered groundwater collected in early May 2000 contained elevated levels of several heavy metals; these contaminants, however, were not found during a second sampling round at the end of the Month, likely indicating that the initial detections were related to excess turbidity (suspended soil particles present in the sample) and were not representative of ambient groundwater conditions.

The report noted that Enviro Testing stated that there were possible "Class V injection wells" at the property (including near the automotive repair facility) and that there were potential buried railroad cars used as fuel tanks, which were located at an adjoining property (later reports make clear that this property is located off-Site east of Hudson Street, but that fuel lines carried oil onto the southeastern portion of the Site).

The GeoLogic Tank Removal Report documented removal of three underground storage tanks (USTs; 275-gallon fuel oil, and 1,000-gallon naphtha and gasoline tanks) at the northwestern portion of Lot 2. Although holes were observed in the fuel-oil UST, and the other tanks were pitted, no field evidence of contamination was observed and soil testing documented an absence of contamination (note, however, that testing was limited to petroleum compounds only; samples were not analyzed for either chlorinated solvents or PCBs).

According to NPV, the 2001 GeoLogic report stated that additional work was completed based on the discovery of petroleum in a manhole located on the southeast corner of the property. Five borings were drilled (one near the former gasoline station, one along the southern property line, one in the central portion of the property and two at the southeast corner of the property) and six test pits were excavated in the southeast corner of the property. Cut pipes with residual petroleum, extending from the adjoining property to the east, were encountered and removed from test pits along the eastern side of the property. Soil samples from the southeastern portion of the property had field evidence of petroleum contamination and elevated levels of petroleum compounds. The piping was reportedly "likely connected to the four underground storage tanks that had been located on the east side of Hudson Street. These former tanks were reported to be buried railroad cars with a capacity of 10,300 gallons. These tanks provided fuel to the Vail-Ballou boiler room that had been located near the southeastern portion of the property)." Groundwater impacts were limited to low-level exceedances for acetone and chloroform, and low levels of petroleum (at the southeast corner). [Note: While the information regarding elevated levels of acetone and chloroform appears to be credible, supporting documentation is not available for direct review and this information is provided in overall support of the Sitehistory narrative and is not intended to document current Site groundwater conditions.]

According to NPV, the 2008 GeoLogic Phase I ESA and Direct Push Sampling Report stated that two existing groundwater monitoring wells were sampled and borings were extended at multiple locations, including "downgradient of the property boundary", in the vicinity of the former gasoline station and the 2000 tank removal area, near the former petroleum pipes, and several other areas. Groundwater sampling documented chloroform, tetrachloroethene, acetone, and several polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons at concentrations

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below NYSDEC groundwater standards. No soils samples appear to have been submitted for laboratory analysis.

The 2008 Phase I ESA and Direct Push Sampling Report reportedly identified historical automotive repair activities circa 1995 (including a floor drain that likely discharged on the subject property), historical use of USTs (gasoline and other materials) at the western portion of the Site, and a fuel-oil spill event (No. 1702628) at a southwestern adjoining property as well as several historical nearby gasoline filling stations. The 2023 GBTS Phase I ESA generally confirmed the 2008 findings and indicated that all Site structures, with exception of the commercial building at Lot 30, had been demolished by circa 2018-2019.

The 2023 Phase II Environmental Investigation documented collection of twenty surface soil samples (0-4"); elevated levels of metals and/or polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) were found above NYSDEC RRU SCOs at all Site tax lot parcels. The 2025 Summary Report of Subsurface confirmed these findings by documenting significant contamination in subsurface soil collected from as deep as approximately 13 feet in fourteen (14) test pits throughout the Site; PAH and metals impacts at several locations were reported at concentrations over 30 times the applicable RRU SCO.

Narrative Description of Documented Site Contamination

The following contamination has been documented above SCGs (see Figure 8, and the data summary tables provided below). Soil results were compared to NYSDEC Remedial Program RRU SCOs and groundwater results were compared to NYSDEC Class GA Ambient Water Quality Standards (AWQS; TOGS 1.1.1).

Relevant Site Geology and Hydrogeology

Geotechnical and environmental investigation findings identified fill soil (sand, gravel, brick, cinders and ash) from the surface to as deep as approximately 13 feet bgs, underlain by native glacial outwash (bedrock was not encountered to a maximum depth of 50 feet bgs). Groundwater was present between approximately 15 to 23 feet bgs, and direction of shallow groundwater flow was determined to be easterly.

Site Media

Documentation of soil contamination above RRU SCOs was established by the 2023 and 2025 GBTS soil sampling events. Elevated SVOCs (restricted to PAHs) were reported in multiple lots and elevated metals were reported at all Site lots, including arsenic, barium, chromium, copper, lead, and mercury. Lead and several SVOCs are documented at concentrations over 30 times RRU SCOs, and arsenic is reported over 9 times the RRU (maximum 149 ppm), indicating a significant potential exposure risk.

Samples were collected from one or more of three permanent wells installed at Lot 2 in 2000, 2001, and 2008, and additionally from soil borings in 2001 and 2008. Although contamination in groundwater reportedly included elevated levels of the volatile organic compounds acetone and chloroform, and metals were found to be elevated in an initial sampling round, these findings are not considered to be representative of Site groundwater for the purposes of the BCP application.

Vapor sampling has not been conducted at the Site.

Tabular Summary of Site Contamination

Soil data submitted in support of the BCP application is tabulated below. All samples submitted for laboratory analysis on December 13, 2023.

SECTION X – REQUESTOR ELIGIBILITY

Bulk Storage Tanks

The Site is not currently registered as a NYSDEC petroleum bulk storage (PBS) facility; an updated PBS form, however, was submitted to NYSDEC on December 5, 2024 indicating the following information:

- Inactive fuel-oil UST (likely to have a capacity of ≤1,000 gallons).
- Closed/removed 275-gallon fuel-oil UST
- Closed/removed 1,000-gallon naphtha UST
- Closed/removed 1,000-gallon gasoline UST

The inactive tank is located at Lot 30, and the remaining USTs were removed from the northwestern portion of Lot 2 in 2000. The PBS record will be updated during the course of the remedial investigation/remediation after the known fuel-oil tank is closed, and (as warranted) if previously undocumented tanks are encountered.

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Volunteer Statement

Requestor seeks to enter into the Brownfield Cleanup Program as a Volunteer. Under ECL § 27-1405(1)(b) and 6 NYCRR §375-3.2(c)(2), a Volunteer is defined as an applicant other than a participant, including without limitation a person whose liability arises solely as a result of such person's ownership or operation of or involvement with the site subsequent to the disposal or discharge of contaminants, provided however, such person exercises appropriate care with respect to contamination found at the facility by taking reasonable steps to:

- i. Stop any continuing release;
- ii. Prevent any threatened future release; and,
- iii. Prevent or limit human, environmental, or natural resource exposure to any previously released contamination.

As described below, the Requestor qualifies as volunteer because (i) the Requestor performed reasonable and prudent due diligence measures during the purchase contract due diligence period; (ii) all disposals of hazardous substances have occurred prior to the date the Requestor acquired title (there is no evidence of a release occurring since acquisition of the site by the Requestor); and (iii) the Requestor does not have any affiliation with any responsible party. The Requestor's liability would arise solely as a result of its ownership or involvement with the redevelopment of the Site subsequent to the disposal of hazardous substances and contaminants. As such, the Requestor qualifies as a Volunteer as defined in ECL 27-1405(1)(b).

The Requestor is submitting this new application, because although the Department previously determined that the Site is not eligible for the reasons set forth in its June 3, 2025 letter, supplemental investigation has since been conducted that documents (as evidenced herein) that the proposed Site indeed qualifies as a brownfield site.

Proof of Site Access

Requestor is a contract vendee of the Site and will purchase the property and perform remediation simultaneous with its construction financing for the new buildings. Requestor has full access to all areas of the property for investigations per its agreement with the current landowners. The Requestor has the ability to place an environmental easement on the Site if a Track 1 cleanup has not been achieved after remediation is complete.

Response to Item 5 (Has the requestor previously been denied entry to the BCP?)

A NYSDEC letter dated June 3, 2025, in regard to a BCP application for the Site previously submitted in March 2025, stated that "The Department has determined... that the proposed site is not a brownfield site... the Department must deny your request..." NYSDEC stated that the denial was based on insufficient data to indicate that remediation should be conducted under the BCP, and that the requestor may re-apply with new information. This current submission includes the required additional data confirming that Site contamination is sufficient for entry into the BCP.

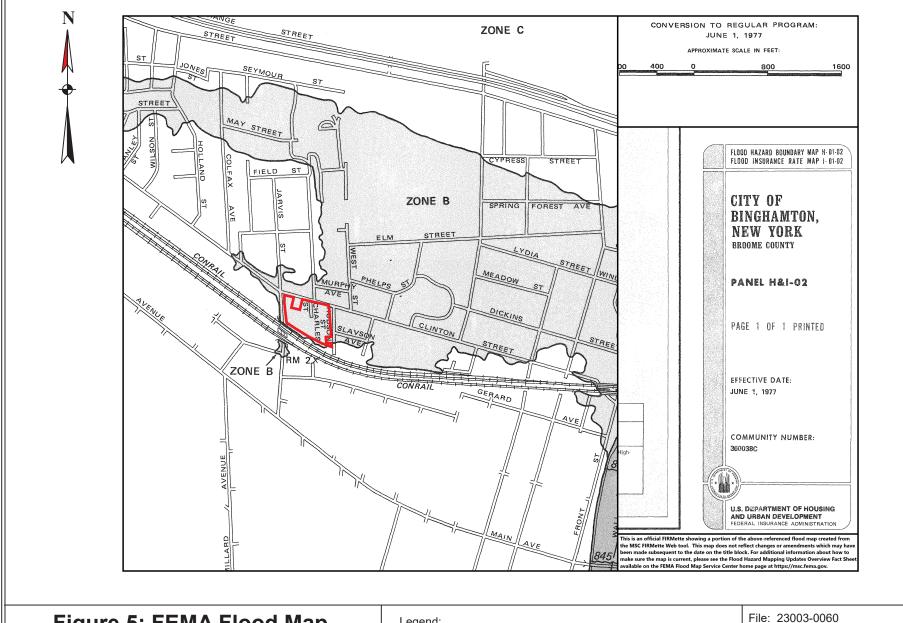
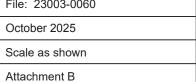
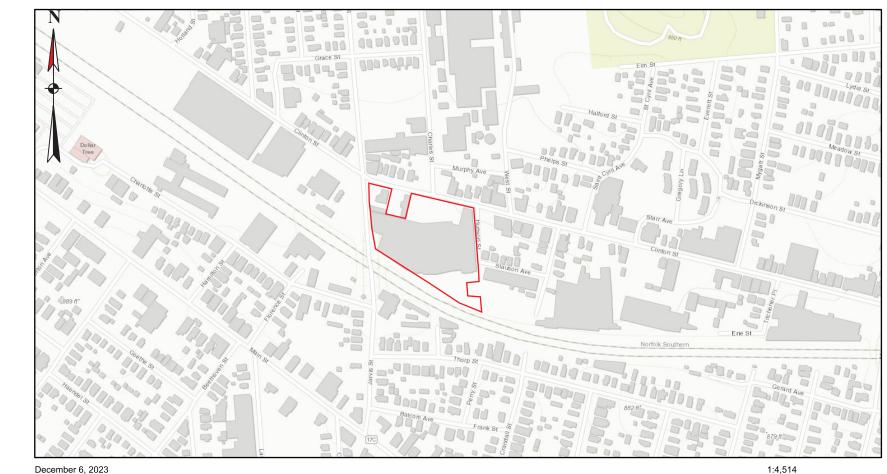


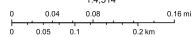
Figure 5: FEMA Flood Map

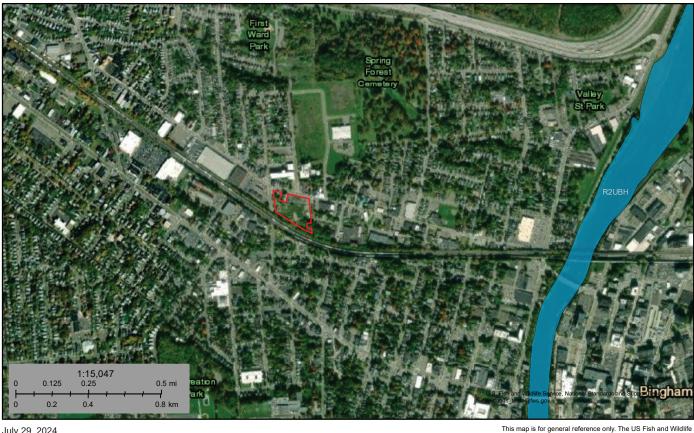

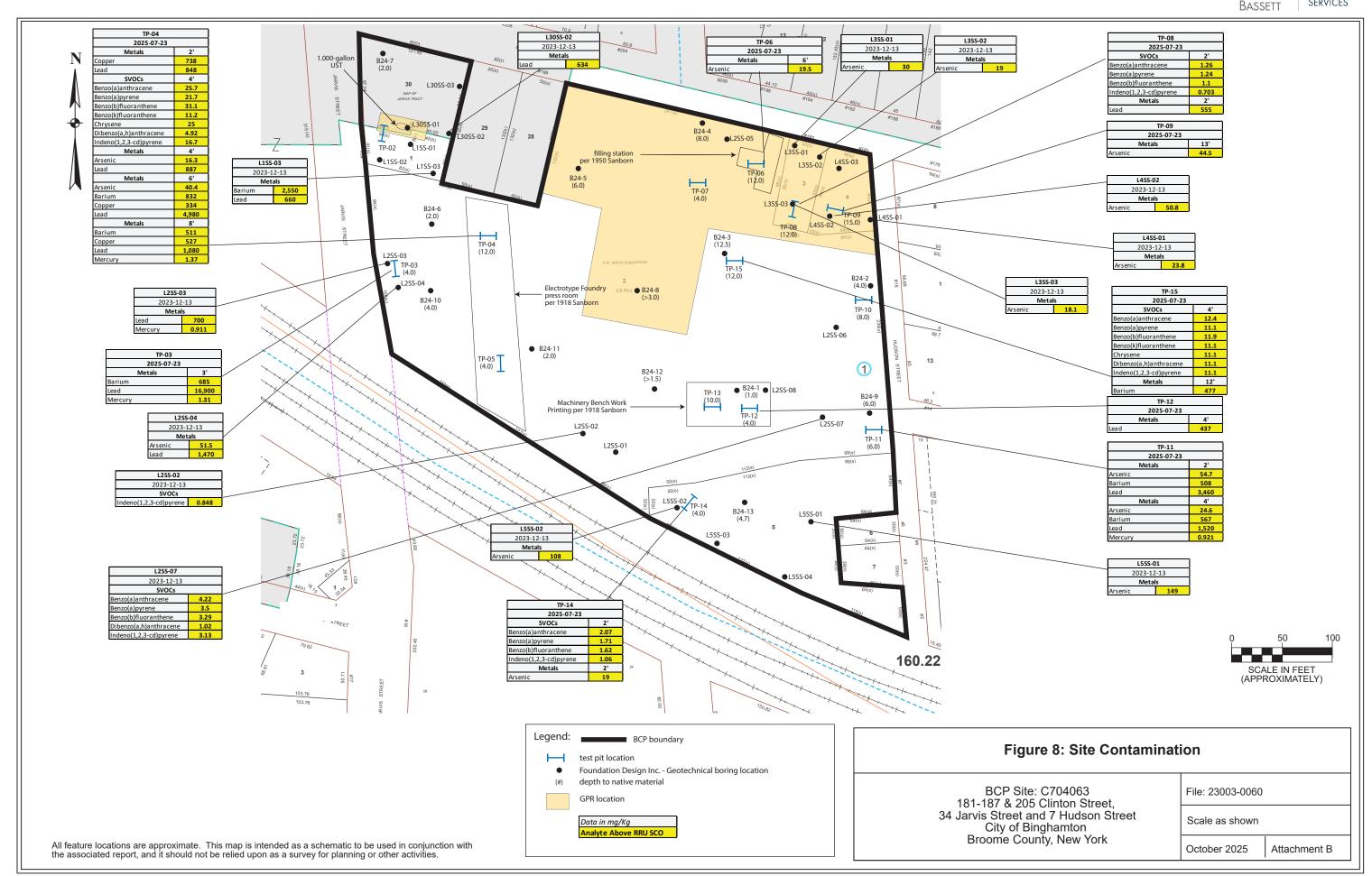

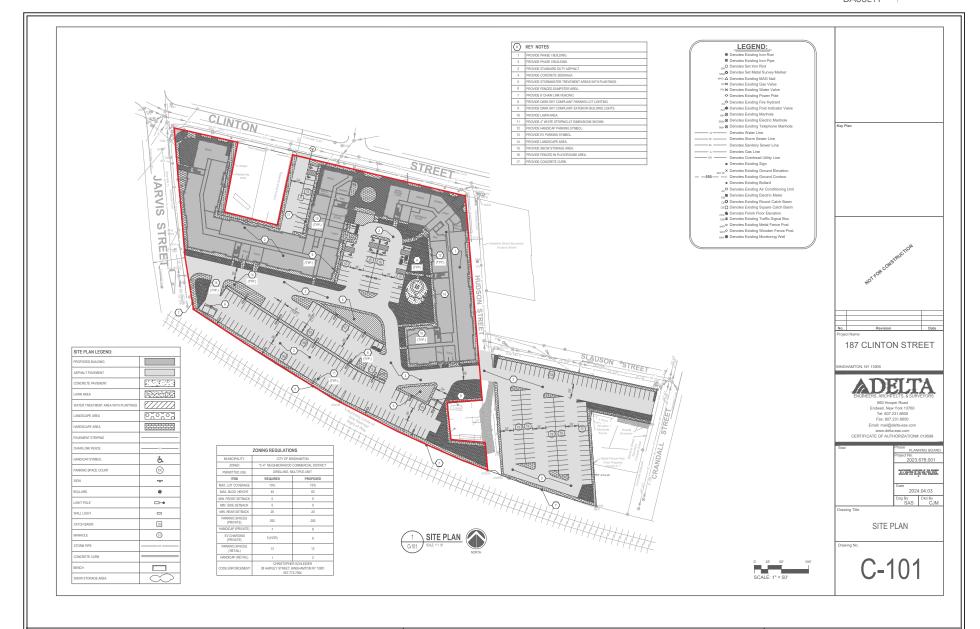


Figure 9: Development Plan

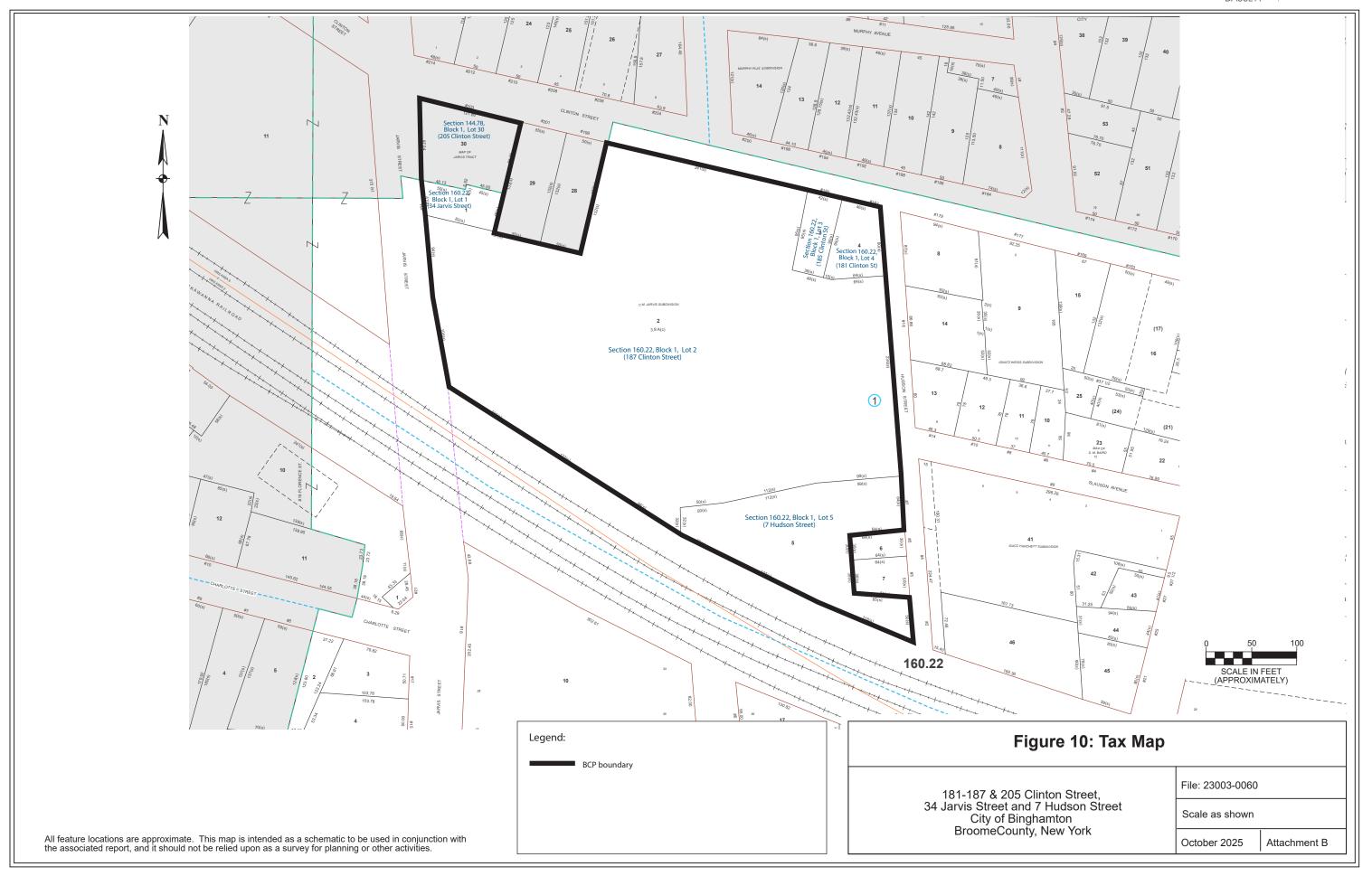
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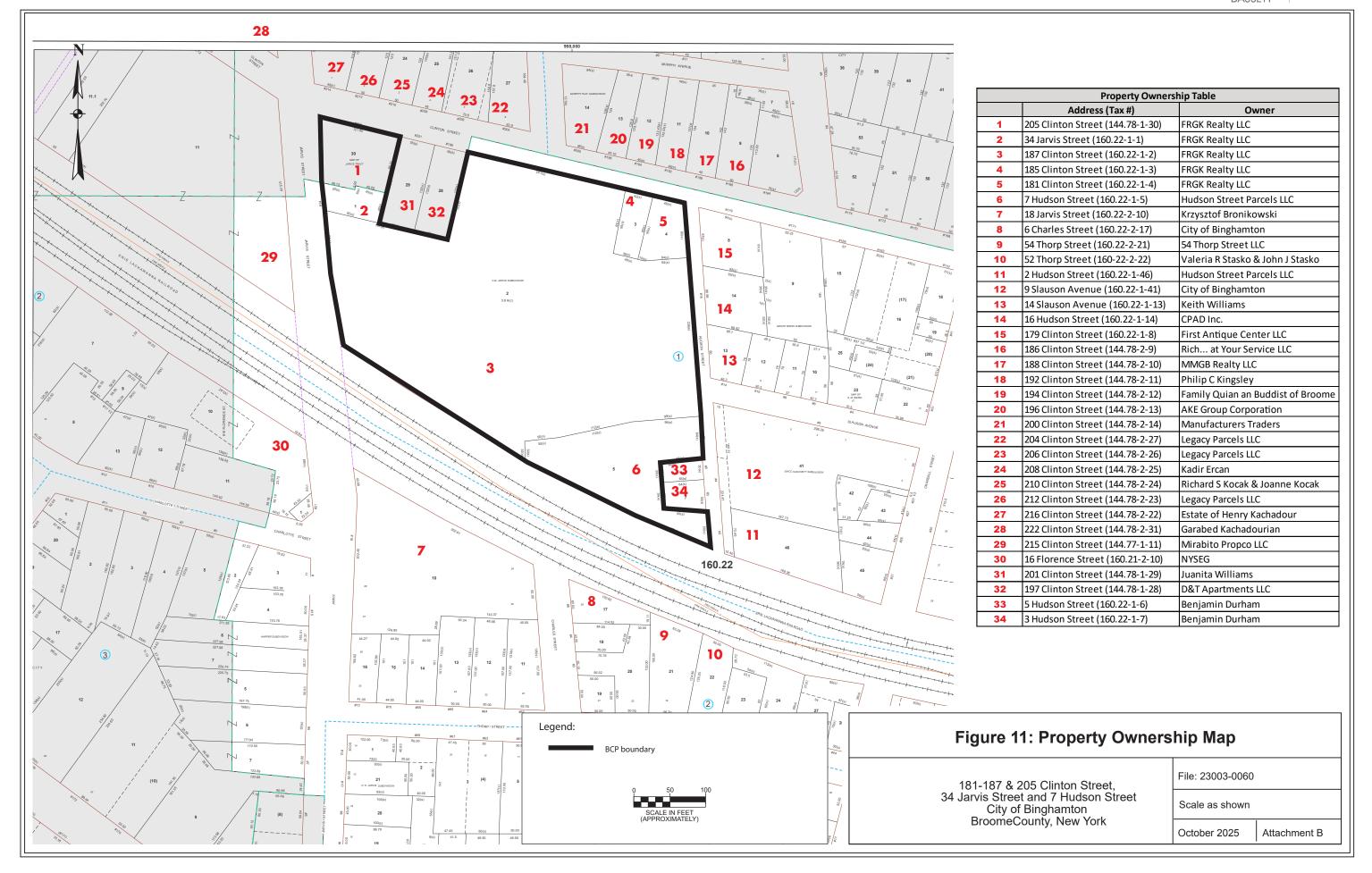

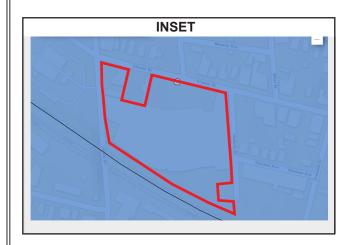












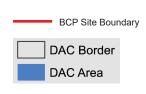


Figure 13: Disadvantaged Communities Map

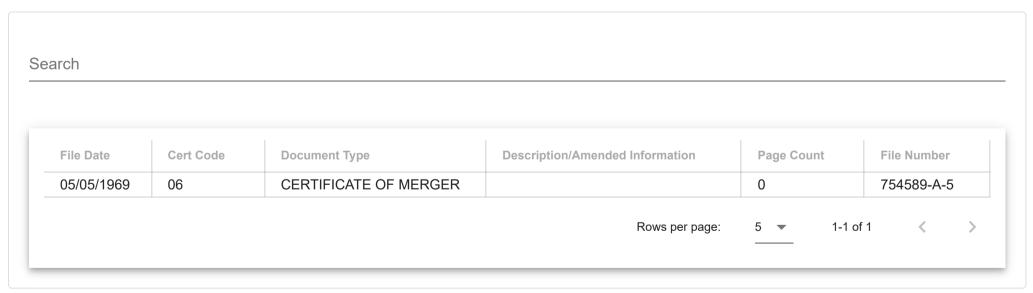
