The amendment is to remove: (1) a portion of the defined BCA site that was appropriated in 1951 by the New York State Public Works for the construction of State Route 54; and, (2) a 0.617 acre parcel that was subdivided and sold to an adjacent commercial business (Shirley's of Bath, Inc.) in 2018 that was encroaching on it and utilizing it for customer parking purposes.					
As it applies to the appropriated land, it had been inadvertently included in the original BCA site boundaries, so this amendment is intended to address that Scribner's error. With regard to the 0.617 acre site, the sale was effectuated to address the ongoing encroachment and use by the adjacent property owner on property that had not been utilized or managed for an extended period of time by the landowner. At the time, the sale was communicated with the Department Project Manager, though a 60-Day Advance Change of Use Notification Form was inadvertently not submitted.

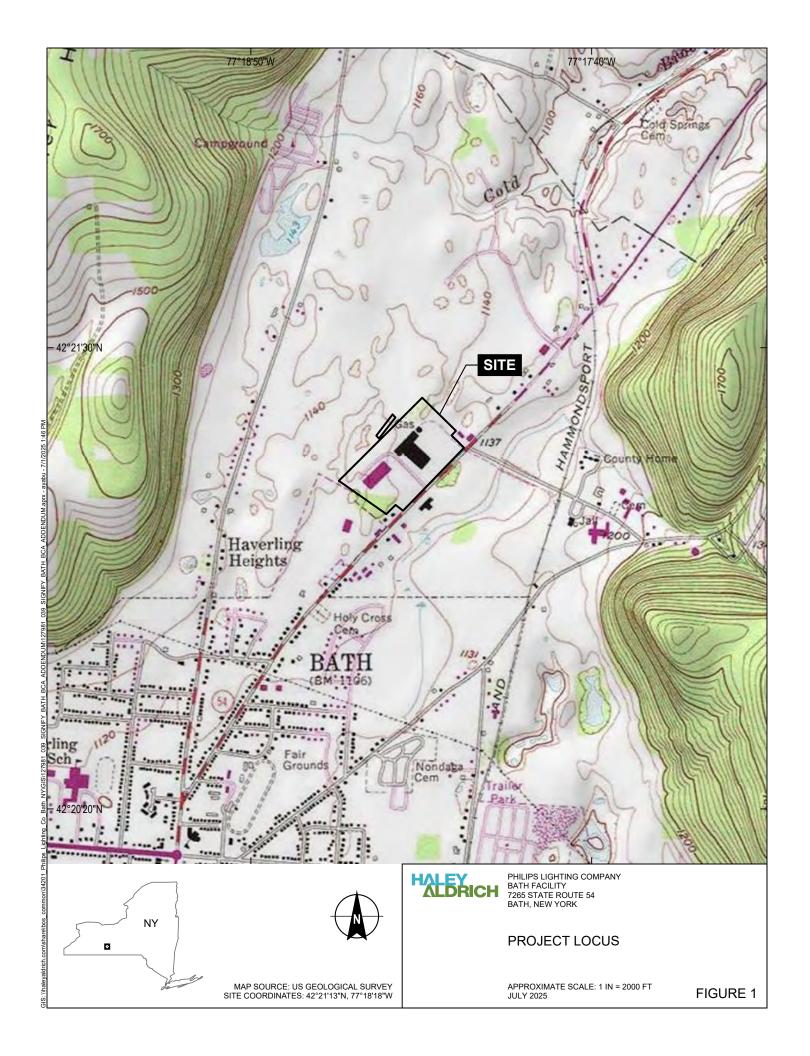

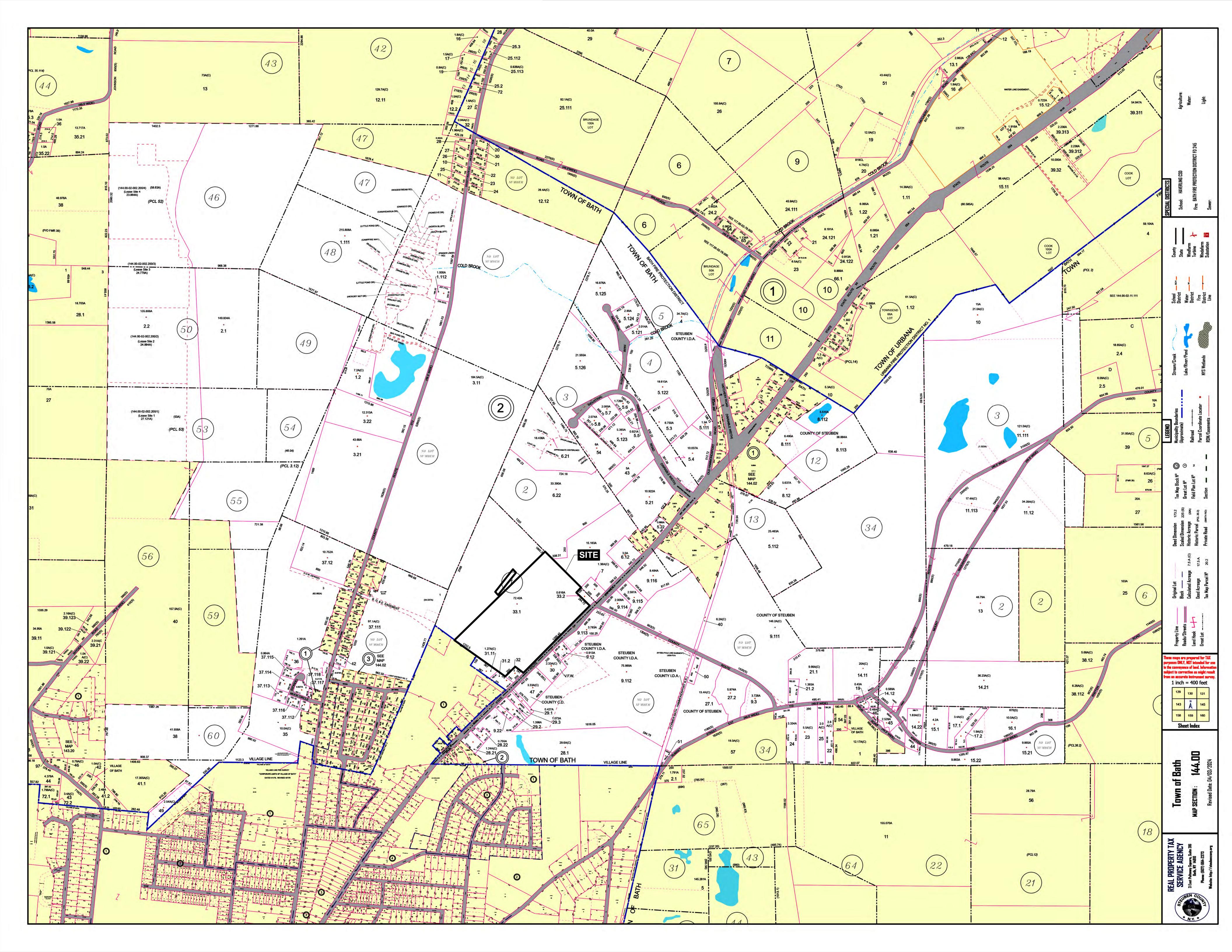

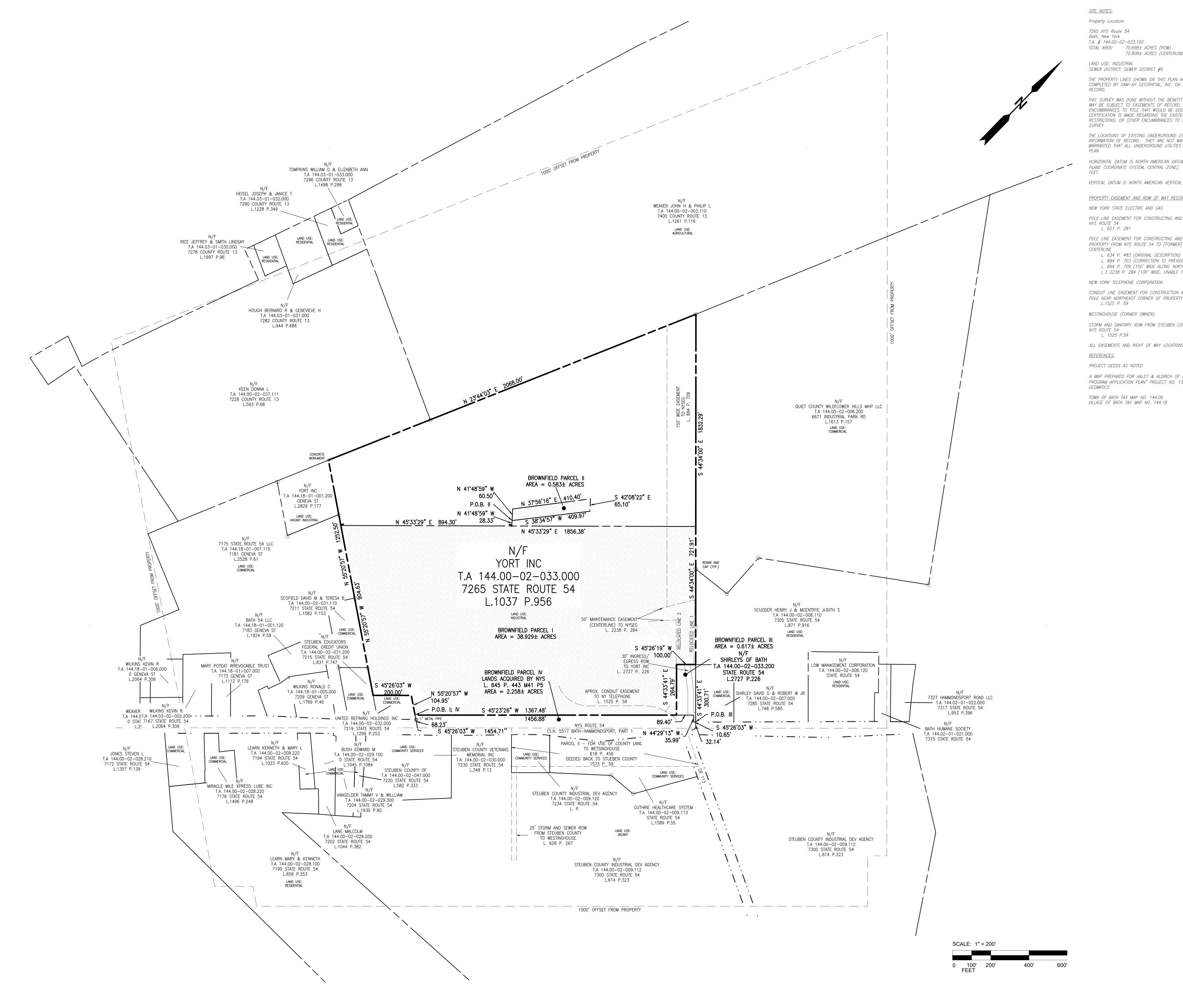
