Dear Mr. Blades:

This letter is forwarded to your attention in response to the request submitted to amend the Brownfield Cleanup Agreement (“BCA” or “Agreement”) signed on October 8, 2010. The request, submitted by Thomas M. Tuori, Esq., requested that the above-noted BCA be amended by adding a parcel strip of land to the eastern boundary to the original BCA site. This area is depicted on a site plan map attached to your letter as Exhibit “A”, containing 0.54 +/- acres of land, and is part of that parcel identified as Tax Map Identification No. 171-1-59.

The above request is hereby granted and incorporated into and is enforceable pursuant to the subject Agreement effective immediately upon receipt of this letter. In reliance upon, and in furtherance of these letters and previous discussions, if any, of this matter between the Department staff and the Brownfield Cleanup Program (BCP) applicant’s representatives to date. Specifically, the property set forth on Exhibit “A” is hereby added to the definition of the “site.”

This Amendment is made in accordance with and subject to all of the BCA and all applicable guidance, regulations and state laws applicable thereto. All other substantive and procedural terms of the Agreement will remain unchanged and in full force and effect regarding the parties to the Agreement.
