### Environmental Investigation and Cleanup Work to begin at the Former Signore Facility Work Plans Available for Public Comment

September 2011

#### Introduction

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) welcomes public comment as it reviews a draft Supplemental Remedial Investigation (SRI) Work Plan for the Former Signore Facility Brownfield Cleanup Program Site located at 55 Jefferson Street, Ellicottville, Cattaraugus County. The SRI work plan outlines supplemental environmental investigation activities to be performed at the site which will help to further determine the nature and extent of contamination and aide in developing cleanup options, if necessary. In addition, an Interim Remedial Measures (IRM) Work Plan has been prepared that outlines remedial activities that can be taken quickly without extensive investigation to address an environmental problem. This interim work is scheduled to commence in early September 2011. Previous industrial activities at the site have contaminated soil, groundwater, and soil vapor.



The investigation work will be performed under New York State's Brownfield Cleanup Program (BCP). The BCP provides existing or potential property owners financial incentives to promote the voluntary cleanup and redevelopment of brownfield sites. Brownfields typically are former industrial properties where the real or perceived presence of contamination impedes reuse of the site. Iskalo Ellicottville Holdings LLC took ownership of the property in 2008. Iskalo submitted a BCP Application to NYSDEC for an 8.43-acre portion (Signore BCP Area) of the property. The Signore BCP Area was accepted into the BCP in January 2011, when NYSDEC issued and executed a Brownfield Cleanup Agreement with Iskalo Ellicottville Holdings.

#### Is the Site a Threat to Public Health?

Previous investigations at the site have identified contamination in site soil and groundwater. Currently, there are no known immediate health impacts to site users or the surrounding community. In the early 1990's,

significant off-site migration of contaminants was addressed through the New York State Superfund Program. Remedial work completed under the NYS Superfund program included: 1) Installation of an interceptor well upgradient of the Town drinking water well; 2) Connection of 34 residential properties to the municipal water supply source; and 3) Installation of an interceptor well on a downgradient portion of the Signore property. The current proposed investigation and IRM work is intended to evaluate potential health risks associated with remaining residual on-site contamination.

#### Public Comments about the Remedial Investigation Work Plan

The SRI Work Plan and IRM Work Plan are available for public viewing at the locations listed in this fact sheet. NYSDEC will accept written public comments about the SRI Work Plan for 30 days, from **September 12 to October 19, 2011**. Written comments should be submitted to the DEC project manager listed on the following page. Please be aware that cleanup work included in the IRM work plan is scheduled to begin at the beginning of September. Comments regarding the IRM work plan, received after implementation of the IRM work will be considered when determining a final remedy for the site.

#### What Will the Upcoming Investigation Work Involve?

The planned IRM work will address known areas of petroleum contamination present in the vicinity of underground storage tanks (USTs) present outside of the building. The IRM work will include:

- Excavating USTs;
- Removal and off-site disposal of contaminated soil around the USTs, if present and
- Collection of soil and groundwater samples.

The planned SRI will provide further environmental data to determine the nature and extent of contamination and if certain areas of the site require cleanup or other remedial precautions. The RI work will include:

- Demolishing, or partial demolition, of on-site buildings;
- Drilling soil probes;
- Installing temporary groundwater monitoring wells, and
- Sampling and analyzing surface and subsurface soil, groundwater, and sub-slab soil vapor and indoor air to evaluate risks to human health, if any.

#### **Next Steps**

NYSDEC will consider public comments before it approves the SRI work plan and will consider comments regarding the IRM Work Plan during evaluation of the final remedy. The approved plan will be available for public review at the locations listed below and on the DEC website (see link below). The SRI fieldwork is expected to occur in summer/fall 2011. NYSDEC will keep the public informed during the cleanup and redevelopment process of the Former Signore Facility site through fact sheets similar to this one.

#### Site Background

The former Signore facility property has been used for manufacturing purposes for over 50 years. The facility was primarily used for the machining and fabrication of metal parts. In 1986, the Signore facility underwent a soil and groundwater sampling program which identified Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) contamination. Specifically, trichloroethene (TCE) and trichloroethane (TCA) were identified as contaminants of concern at the site. Downgradient public and private drinking water wells were impacted. The contamination was attributed to spills, leakage and other plant operations. In August 1989 the property was placed in the NYSDEC State Superfund Program as Site Number 905023. In the early 1990s, the site was investigated and remediated to address public health issues associated with the off-site migration of contaminants.

In October 2007, a Phase II Environmental Site Assessment identified VOC contamination and separate phase petroleum (SPP) product in soil and groundwater on the site. Three areas of concern (AOC) were identified. AOC-1 and AOC-2 will be addressed as part of the proposed IRM Work. AOC-3 is located beneath the existing building and will be addressed at a later time after the building is demolished. The proposed SRI work will be completed following existing building demolition, or partial demolition to better assess contamination that may exist beneath the building, as well as, assess potential off-site soil vapor contamination.
