The Department of Environmental Conservation is investigating hazardous waste contamination that has occurred on or near Village of Mayville property.

The sampling is planned to begin during the Fall of 2009. The SBLs for the properties we wish to access are 110-4-1 and 111.3.1.2.1. Both properties are on West Lake Road and are adjacent to the Boxcar Barney property and the Village Town Park.

Pursuant to ECL Article 56 §0515.1, the Department and its contractors are authorized to enter onto property for these purposes.
