## Brownfield Clean Up Application Final Remedial Investigation Report Proposed Remedial Work Plan

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) working cooperatively with the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH), has received an application for the Brownfield Cleanup Program for the East River Plaza Site (Site # C231045).

**Site Description:** The site, located in East Harlem, New York between E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street and E. 119<sup>th</sup> Street, is approximately 4.5 acres in size, and was the location of the former Washburn Wire Manufacturing facility. The manufacturing activities were terminated on the site in the 1980s. Since that time the site has been vacant.

**Site Investigations and the Planned Action:** Extensive site investigations since 1995 indicated leaks and spills from site activities and underground storage tanks. Test pits were excavated (2004) to groundwater and indicated two separate areas of petroleum and metal contaminated soils.

The applicant plans to clean up existing contamination at the site and redevelop the property for a commercial retail and possible residential use. Approximately 30, 000 cubic yards of contaminated soils will be excavated and disposed off-site. A future fact sheet will describe the proposed remediation prior to the cleanup.
