A Notice of Intent to Modify CWM Chemical Services - Model City Site's State Pollution Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) permit was noticed in the Environmental Notice Bulletin on October 17, 2007, with the comment period ending November 16, 2007.

Due to the public interest in the permit modification and under the Uniform Procedures Act (UPA) Regulations, 6NYCRR Section 621.14(a) a 60 day extension of the public comment period has been granted until January 15, 2008.

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYS DEC) administers the Brownfield Cleanup Program (BCP) pursuant to State Environmental Conservation Law (ECL) 27-1400 et seq. Wyoming County - The Town of Gainesville, as lead agency, has determined that the proposed 2007 amendments to the Town of Gainesville Zoning Law will not have a significant adverse environmental impact. The action involves the proposed amendments which will provide a
