



#### **INTRODUCTION**

The following provides a brief summary of the Site:

- The Site is located within a historic industrial zone of the City of Buffalo, containing former industrial, commercial, residential, vacant and recreational areas. The former Ohio Basin and shipping canal was located immediately adjacent to the east of the Site, and was subsequently filled in and is currently utilized as the City of Buffalo Conway Park.
- There are no State or Federal wetlands or floodplains located on-Site. Per the Erie County GIS System, floodplains are located approximately 250-ft to the west along the Buffalo River.
- The Site is not adjacent to a Significant Coastal Fish and Wildlife Habitat.
- A NYSDEC regulated freshwater wetland (BU-3) is located approximately 0.75-miles to the northwest of the site (see Figure 10-1).
- According to the NYSDEC's Environmental Resource Mapper (ERM) there are important plant habitats, and endangered species listed for the area encompassing the Site.
  - The Golden Dock (*Rumex fueginus*) is listed as an endangered rare plant species under NYS Protected Status.
  - The American Burying Beetle (*Nicrophorus americanus*) is listed as an endangered rare animal species under NYS Protection Status.
- Two National Register listed historical Sites are located within 0.5 miles of the subject Site. The E&B Holmes Machinery Company Building (NR#: 08NR00597) addressed at 59 Chicago Street, is directly adjacent to the subject Site. The Edward M. Cotter Fireboat (NR#: 97NR01143) addressed at the junction of Michigan Avenue and Ohio Street is located less than 0.25-miles north of the Site (see Figure 10-2).



NEARBY LAND USE MAP





#### SURROUNDING LAND USE DESCRIPTION

The Site is comprised of 11 adjoining parcels totaling an approximate 5.0-acre, located in a historically industrial area of the City of Buffalo, Erie County, New York. The Site is bound by Ohio Street and Chicago Street to the west and southwest; Mackinaw Street to the north; and the City of Buffalo – Conway Park to the east (see Figures 1-1 and 1-2). The Buffalo River is located approximately 250-ft to the west of the Site.

The Site is located in a historic industrial area of the City of Buffalo. The land use surrounding the Site is a mixed commercial, vacant, residential and recreational area. Residential areas surrounding the site are located approximately 0.2-miles to the east, and 0.4-miles to the north. A surrounding land use map is provided as Figure 11-1.

#### POTENTIAL VULNERABILITY OF GROUNDWATER TO CONTAMINATION

Petroleum-related volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and semi-volatile organic compounds (SVOCs) were detected in subsurface soil samples during a limited site investigation conducted in 2010. In addition, multiple NYSDEC Spill files have been recorded for operations on-Site, and municipal records indicate historic leaking underground storage tanks (USTs). Attachment 5 includes a summary of the previous environmental investigations and historic records.

Currently, there are no known deed restrictions on the use of groundwater at the Site. Municipal water is available to the Site and all properties in the area. The municipal water is supplied by the Buffalo Water Authority, and is derived from Lake Erie and the Niagara River.

#### **GROUNDWATER FLOW**

Based on information from the previous limited environmental investigations, groundwater was typically encountered between eight (8) to ten (10) feet below ground surface (fbgs). The Site is located approximately 250-ft east of the Buffalo River and localized Site groundwater is generally estimated to flow in a western direction.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

Further work is required to investigate groundwater quality data. Additional wells to assess groundwater flow patterns and water quality will be needed.

#### **ECOLOGICAL SETTING**

The majority of the Site is covered with existing buildings, asphalt parking and driveways. Some grass covered areas are present in the northwest quadrant of the Site.

The Site is located in the Lake Erie-Niagara River Basin, which generally drains west/southwest from the Site, although localized variation may occur. Viable aquatic habitats in the vicinity of the Site include the Buffalo River (approximately 250-ft west) and Lake Erie (approximately 1 mile west).

#### **DEMOGRAPHY AND LAND USE**

The Site is located in highly developed urbanized area of the City of Buffalo, Erie County, NY. Land use surrounding the Site includes commercial, residential, and some vacant properties (see Figure 11-1).

#### REGIONAL GEOLOGY/HYDROGEOLOGY

The Site is located within the Erie-Ontario lake plain physiographic province, which is typified by little topographic relief and gentle slope toward Lake Erie, except in the immediate vicinity of major drainageways (USDA, 1978). The surficial geology of the Lake Erie Plain consists of a thin glacial till (if present), glaciolacustrine deposits, recent alluvium, and the soils derived from these deposits.

Surface soils within the City are characterized as urban land with level to gently sloping land in which 80 percent or more of the soil surface is covered by asphalt, concrete, buildings, or other impervious structures (USDA, 1978) typical of an urban environment. The presence of overburden fill material is widespread and common throughout the City of Buffalo

Based on the bedrock geologic map of Erie County (Buehler and Tesmer, 1963), the Site is situated over Onondaga Formation of the Middle Devonian Series. The Onondaga Formation is comprised of a varying texture from coarse to very finely crystalline with a dark gray to tan color and chert and fossils within. The unit has an approximated thickness of 110 to 160 feet.

#### SITE GEOLOGY/HYDROGEOLOGY

Based on the previous investigation (see Attachment 05), the geology at the Site is generally described as fill materials overlying silty clay and sand-gravel. The fill materials consist of sand and gravel with varying amounts of asphalt, brick, gravel, clay, sand and silt at depths ranging from 0 to 8 feet below ground surface (fbgs). Black sand/silty sand was noted in across most of the Site.

Site groundwater will be investigated during the Remedial Investigation fieldwork.
