Underground Storage Tank (UST) removal and associated environmental remediation services were performed by Nature's Way Environmental Consultants and Contractors, Inc. (NWECC&C, Inc.) under contract to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) - Region 9 on a parcel located at 356 Hertle Avenue, Buffalo, New York. One (1) 4000 gallon former petroleum UST, was discovered during unrelated site activities which prompted remediation at this site. This tank was found to have been previously fill with concrete, and significant (puddles) residual product.

Tank removal efforts, as well as associated petroleum contaminated soils removal at the above referenced site, commenced on December 13th, 2002 and continued through December 19th, 2002. The one (1) 4000 gallon UST was located, and liquid contents were transferred (pumped) into an on-site poly tank. A backhoe equipped with a hydraulic hammer was utilized to break the concrete, which was disposed of as contaminated waste. The shell of the 4K gallon tank was cleaned and disposed of as scrap.

An Organic Vapor Meter (as well as visual and olfactory observations) was utilized by an on-site NWECC&C, Inc. field technician to provide an objective basis for soil screening; soils exhibiting an OVM reading of greater than 10 ppm were considered to be petroleum impacted (contaminated) and removed. (See Attachment 1 - Limits of Excavation / Sample Location Map)

200 gallons of petroleum contaminated water encountered within the tank (which also contained concrete) were transferred from the on-site poly holding tank into a NWECC&C, Inc. tanker, and transported to Industrial Oil Tank Services, Oriskany, New York for treatment / disposal.

Petroleum contaminated soils were staged, on plastic, on-site, until landfill characterization analysis was complete, and landfill approval was received. A total of 457.48 tons of petroleum contaminated soils were loaded by NWECC&C, Inc into trucks permitted to haul special waste provided by Modern Disposal Services, Inc. on January 6th, January 7th, 2003 and transported to the Modern Landfill Facility, in Model City, New York.

Disposal documentation is included in Attachment 2 of this report.

Once excavation was complete (exhibiting OVM readings less than 10 ppm), confirmatory samples were secured from the final excavation walls and bottom. These samples were then submitted to Life Science Laboratories, Inc. and analyzed for the presence of NYSDEC STARS List volatile organic compounds by EPA Methods 8021.

No STARS list compounds were identified in any of the samples at concentrations above applicable regulatory guidance values contained in NYSDEC TAGM #4046 for the NYSDEC STARS List for volatile organic compounds. Copies of the laboratory analytical reports are included as Attachment 3 of this report.

A review of historical records held at the City of Buffalo Fire was conducted by NWEC&C, Inc. on January 2nd, 2003. (All Documents obtained at the City of Buffalo Fire Prevention Bureau for the property located at 356 Hertle Avenue, Buffalo, New York are included as Attachment 4 of this report). Several documents regarding USTs were identified:

An application dated September 1962 for the installation of a 1000 gallon gasoline UST for Pollard G. Park.

A hand drawn map illustrating UST and associated feature locations, with the note "Replaced September 1969".

A document dated September 1969 "Replace one (1) 1000 gallon underground tank (leaker) with one (1) 4000 gallon, underground, gasoline storage tank." for Insulation Distributors of 356 Hertle Avenue

Additional information (handwritten with date of 4-8-86) "tank taking in water + rust in cars" Bob Stawbrick, Buffalo Insulation, 356 Hertle.

There is also documentation of one (1) 4000 gallon tank slushed on April 21, 1986, with owner of premises being Buffalo Insulation.

Based upon this information, and the remedial effort performed of this site, we request that the existing petroleum spill file for the site be closed with the designation "meets standards."

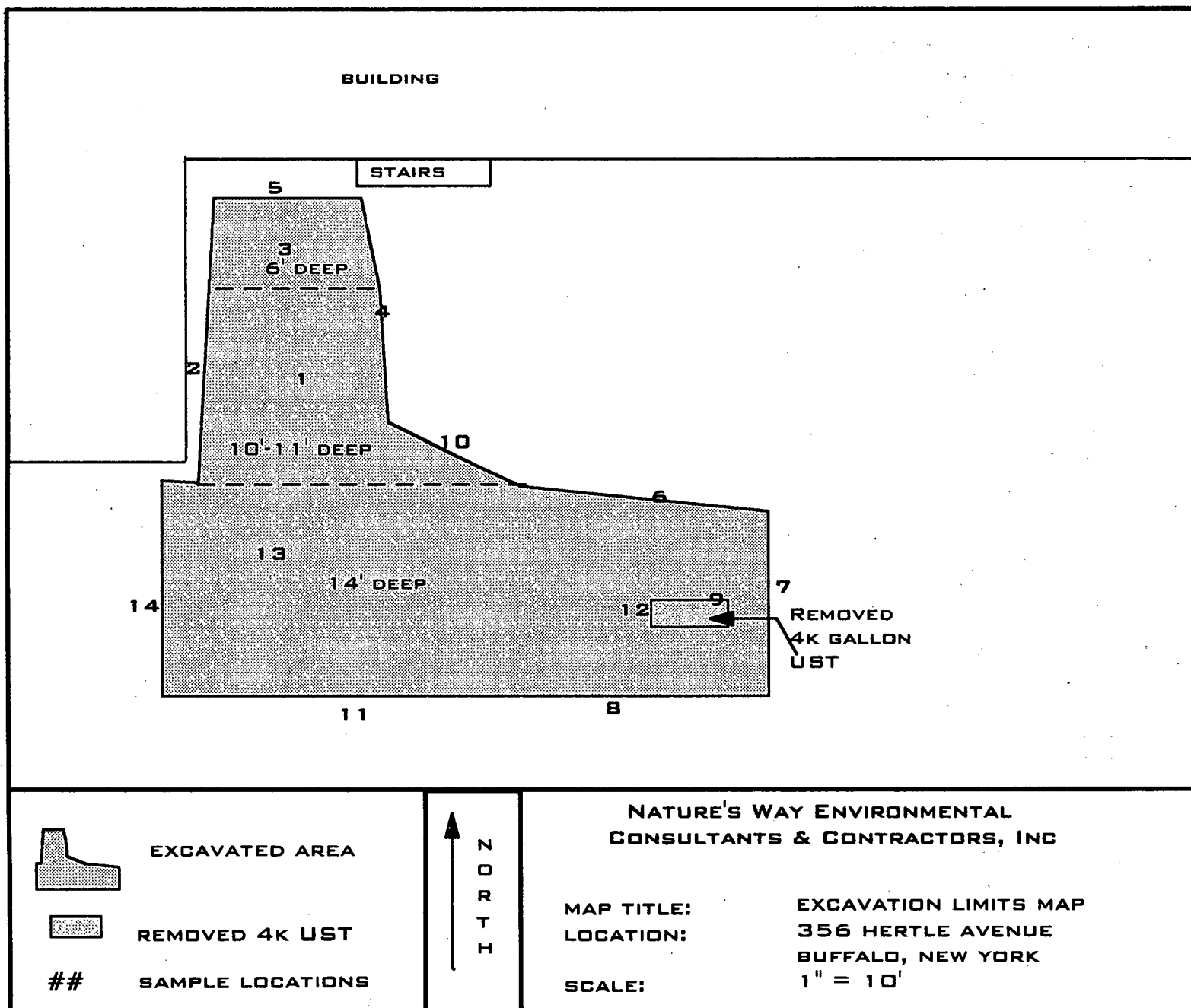


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Attachment 1
