Notice of Records of Decision

The Records of Decision (RODs) for Operable Units 01 and 02 of the **68 West First Street Site (DEC Site #: E738040) (Oswego, Oswego County)** have been issued by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC). The RODs present the remedies chosen to address contamination in relation to the site.

Actions associated with these remedies include, but are not limited to: excavation and disposal of contaminated soil; treatment of groundwater; development of a site cover system; and evaluation of the potential for soil vapor issues.
