#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

#### 1.1 Purpose

Delta Environmental Consultants, Inc. (Delta) has been retained by Sara Lee Corporation to conduct a Phase I Environmental Assessment (Phase I) at the Champion Products Company (Champion) facility located in Perry, New York. This assessment was performed in general conformance with the scope and limitations of ASTM Standard E1527-97. The purpose of the Phase I is to document current site conditions and determine areas of environmental concern for the site and/or surrounding properties.

#### 1.2 Methodology

The following activities were conducted as part of the Phase I:

- a) Site reconnaissance
  - interview(s) were conducted with personnel familiar with past and present operations and environmental history of the site;
  - visual observations were made at the site for evidence of activities indicating use, treatment, storage, or disposal of hazardous substances or wastes;
  - visual review was made of adjacent properties for potential environmental impact on the subject property; and,
  - photo-documentation of current site activities and conditions was obtained.

#### b) Site data review

- · aerial photographs were reviewed;
- interviews were conducted with persons knowledgeable of historic site activities;
- a topographic map was reviewed;
- · zoning and tax maps were reviewed;
- applicable databases provided by Environmental Data Resources, Inc. (EDR), a private firm that conducts federal and state database searches, were reviewed.

#### 2.0 SITE DESCRIPTION

The site is located at Road 2 and North Main Street in Perry, New York, as shown in Figures 1 and 2. The Champion facility primarily produces print screened apparel for sports teams and retail sale.

The facility consists of:

• A warehouse/manufacturing building constructed by Champion in 1955. The building has had various

additions and renovations and encompasses approximately 84,000 square feet (sq. ft.). An addition in 1993

added a second, mezzanine floor, to the building.

A one-story office building along the frontage road (North Main Street). The office building is a block

building of approximately 8,000 sq. ft. and was constructed in 1955 the previous property owner.

Champion purchased the office building in 1975.

The Champion facility is approximately 92,000 square feet and is located on a parcel of land that consists of

approximately 2.5 acres.

Champion is bordered to the north and west mainly by residential housing. A small used car dealership borders

the northwestern edge of the property. A residence borders the northeastern portion of the site, while the

remaining eastern and southern property is bounded by wooded and open vacant land. An tributary stream flows

along the western and southern boundary of the site.

The office building consists of one floor and was constructed in 1955. According to Clark Rice and Ben Maglio,

prior to Champion purchasing the building in 1975, the building was reportedly used as a car dealership and

possibly a gasoline station. Following the purchase by Champion, the building was used as a retail outlet store

for screen printed apparel, and then later used as office space.

Interviews with Clark Rice, a long-time resident of Perry, and Ben Maglio, a former owner of the frontage road

property, revealed that the past use of the office building prior to Champion ownership included a car dealership

and gasoline station. Records of property use prior to 1957 were not available from the tax assessors office or

the Wyoming County Clerks office. Only ownership information was recorded. The presence/absence of

underground storage tanks (USTs) is unknown. Neither the EDR database report nor New York Department of

Environmental Conservation (NY DEC) records indicate past or present UST's the property. The USTs were

likely installed prior to the establishment of regulatory requirements for USTs.

Based on our review of the Mount Morris, New York USGS topographic map (Figure 1), surface elevation at

the site is approximately 1,300 feet above mean sea level and is at the top of a geographic ridge.

The site is currently serviced by municipal drinking water and the publicly owned treatment works (POTW) and

has reportedly been serviced by these utilities since the property was purchased by Champion. Historical

services to the site are unknown.

2.1 Site Reconnaissance

Delta representative, Patrick Haller, visited the site on April 23, 1998 to document current site conditions. Mr. Haller

was escorted through the facility by Mr. Ed Gagliardy. Photographs were taken during the reconnaissance and are

presented as Appendix A.

Structures at the site consist of a two-story, 84,000 sq. ft. warehouse/manufacturing building and a one-story, 8,000

sq. ft. office building. The location of each building is shown in Figure 2.

Asphalt paved parking areas are present to the north of the warehouse/manufacturing building and to the west

and south of the one-story office building.

Electrical power service is provided by New York State Electric & Gas. Three electrical transformers are

located on-site west of the warehouse/manufacturing building and are labeled "Non PCB Containing". Stained

oil was not observed at or around the perimeter of the transformers. According to facility personnel, there are

no known historical releases of oil from the transformer.

An above ground storage tank (AST) containing water is located on-site. Stored water would be used as part of

the fire suppression system, if needed. The AST is located at the southwest portion of the property.

2.1.1 Warehouse/Manufacturing

The warehouse/manufacturing building is a two-story building of approximately 84,000 sq. ft. The first floor

includes shipping, receiving, textile material storage, ink storage, manual and automatic print screen machines,

curing ovens, print screen washing, offices, and a cafeteria. The second floor includes the sewing department,

art department and production control.

The primary process at the facility involves the print screening process. Textile fabrics are imprinted with ink

using a print screen with a design pattern, or stencil. Ink is manually or automatically pressed through the print

screen onto the fabric with squeegees. Once the design has been printed onto the fabric, the fabric is placed on a

rolling belt which conveys through a curing oven. The curing ovens are vented through the roof to the

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atmosphere and are Title V permitted emission points. The print screen is made of a mylar-type film which

allows ink to pass through the design stencil. Ink is removed from the screen in the manual screen wash room

using mineral spirits.

Spent mineral spirits and paint thinners are containerized in drums and stored in an outside shed on the west side

of the warehouse/manufacturing building. The shed is designated as a hazardous waste storage area.

Approximately 20 drums were stored in the storage area at the time of the site visit. The shed is completely

enclosed with metal walls and a concrete floor. The wall was sealed to the floor to contain spills. The floor and

surrounding area were inspected and no stains were apparent. Drums of spent mineral spirits and thinners are

disposed of by Northeastern, a waste management company. The waste management company disposes of the

spent mineral spirits by incineration. Empty drums are stored under a covered structure next to the drum storage

area. No staining was apparent in or around the structure.

Print screens are reclaimed by removing the stencil using a solvent. The screens are washed in the screen wash

room. Solvent is sprayed onto the screen to remove the stencil, which then washes to floor drains that lead

directly to a subgrade, concrete pit. The pit is located adjacent to the screen wash room on the south side of the

building. The solvent and ink is pumped above ground by submersible sump pumps to the POTW. The

discharge to the POTW is permitted.

Following the print screen process, any off-specification inking such as spotting is removed at a spot cleaning

booth using a solvent containing approximately 50% by weight of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) The

solvent is spray gunned onto the spot and wiped off with a rag. The rags are collected in small cans at each

booth. The cans are periodically collected and disposed of by Northwestern.

2.1.2 Office Building

This building is currently used by Champion as an office building. Previously it had been used as a retail outlet

store for Champion products. Inspection of the area around the building indicate the presence of an old concrete

pad, typical of service stations and garages.

2.2 Hazardous Waste Generation

The site is currently a large quantity generator of hazardous waste. Waste streams include mineral spirits and

solvents classified as ignitable hazardous wastes, or containing; spent hazardous wastes containing 10% or more

of halogenated compounds, ethane or 1,1,1 trichloroethane, tetrachloroethylene, and methyl alcohol. The waste is

stored in a shed designated for use as hazardous waste storage.

2.3 Surrounding Land Use Survey

The site is zoned M1, manufacturing/light industry. The property is bordered to the north by North Main Street

followed by residences. The site is bordered to the south by an unnamed stream and vacant wooded land and to

the east by a residence and vacant wooded and open land. A small used car dealership borders the northwest

corner of the site while the remaining boarder is bounded by an unnamed tributary which leads to Silver Creek

and residential housing.

3.0 RECORDS REVIEW

3.1 Database Search

Delta retained EDR to conduct a search of federal and state environmental databases to identify facilities of

potential environmental concern located within the radius specified by ASTM standard E1527-97. A copy of the

EDR report is included as Appendix B and a complete list and description of all databases search can be found at

the end of the report. A summary of the database findings is presented in the following sections.

3.1.1 Subject Property

NY SPILLS - A spill of hazardous material/petroleum was recorded August 5, 1990. Cleanup standards were

achieved August 27, 1990. UST's were not involved and no penalty was assessed.

3.1.2 Proximate Properties

The following sites listed on the EDR report are within 1/8 mile of the subject property:

Main & Tempest Street

RCRIS / TRIS- Large quantity generator of hazardous waste. No violations have been found.

FINDS - Facility is monitored or permitted for air emissions under the Clean Air Act.

Tempest Street

RCRIS / FINDS - Large quantity generator of hazardous waste. No violations have been found.

#### 3.1.3 Unmappable Sites

Due to inadequate address information, six sites listed on the EDR report were unmappable, but potentially within one mile of the subject site. None of the unnamed sites were noted to be located adjacent to the site. The following table summarizes the unmappable sites.

#### 3.2 Water Wells

According to the EDR report, one federal water well used for domestic water supply was identified approximately 3/4 mile north of the site. No state water wells were identified within one mile of the site. The closest public water supply was identified approximately one mile southwest of the site at the Perry International Raceway. Major violations have reportedly been issued for this water supply, but the nature of the violations was not recorded in the database.

#### 3.3 Aerial Photographs

An aerial photograph was reviewed for the year 1987. No other aerial photographs were available for the area. The site conditions in the aerial photograph are similar to those present during site reconnaissance.

#### 3.4 Flood Plain Information

A Federal Insurance Administration (FIA) Flood Hazard Boundary map effective November 28, 1975 for Perry, NY was reviewed. The map indicates that the nearest 100-year flood zone is approximately 1,000 feet southwest from the site. The FIA is included as Appendix C.

3.5 Wetlands Information

The Village of Perry Zoning Department provided a copy of a 1987 aerial photograph with area wetlands

outlined. Review of this map shows the site is not designated as a wetland. The nearest designated wetland area

is located approximately 1.5 miles west of the site. The wetland map is included as Appendix D. Damp areas

near the edge of the main parking lot were observed during the site reconnaissance. These areas contained

vegetation such as cat tails and similar water intensive grasses.

3.6 City Directory Review

City directories were not available at the Village of Perry offices or the public library. The Wyoming County

Clerks office was contacted by phone and the information from the phone interview is presented below.

3.7 Interviews

The Wyoming County Clerks office was interviewed by phone to provide historical ownership of the site. Three

tax parcels were identified as the site. The following information was obtained via phone interview:

An undeveloped parcel of approximately 0.25 acres on the northwestern area of the property was purchased

by Champion in June 1979. The parcel has historically been vacant and is currently unused.

A second parcel of approximately 0.6 acres on the northeastern area of the property was purchased by

Champion in 1955. The past use of this property was vacant land/farming. Following purchase, the land was

developed as a parking lot.

• The third parcel of land within the property is approximately 1.88 acres and is the land of primary use by

Champion. The County Clerks office reported that Champion purchased the property in 1955 at which time

the main building was constructed. However, Mr. Benedict Maglio owned and operated a car dealership on

the north area of the property bordering North Main Street until 1975. The car dealership building is now

used by Champion as an office building

Mr. Maglio was interviewed by phone. He stated that he bought the property in 1957 and that the site had

previously been used as a gasoline station. Mr. Maglio removed the pump island when he took over the property.

Mr. Maglio indicated that he did not know if USTs were present when he removed the pump island.

#### 3.8 Sanborn Fire Insurance Map Review

According to EDR, Sanborn Fire Insurance maps are not available for the subject property. The lack of Sanborn coverage is likely due to the lack of on-site structures for the available Sanborn coverage years. Adjacent properties were identified on Sanborn maps for 1913, 1924, 1944 and 1950. Review of the EDR Fire Insurance Map Abstract for the adjacent properties revealed that prior use of surrounding properties had included a hosiery company, hay barns, auto garage, auto repairing and painting, a filling station and residences. The filling station recorded in the abstract is not associated with the suspected historical gasoline station on-site. A copy of the abstract is provided as Appendix E.

#### 4.0 FINDINGS

Delta has performed a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment in conformance with the general scope and limitations of ASTM Practice E 1527. This assessment revealed evidence of environmental conditions in connection with the property. Based upon the results of the Phase I Environmental Assessment, Delta provides the following findings:

- Hazardous Waste Storage: A hazardous waste storage shed containing mineral spirits and thinner is located at the rear of the warehouse/manufacturing building.
- Water Supply Violation: A water supply violation at the Perry International Raceway was identified in the EDR database report.
- <u>Screen Wash Collection Pit:</u> The concrete pit collects solvent from the screen washing process. Although no releases have been identified, the integrity of the pit structure and the potential for historical releases from this pit has not been established.
- Frontage Road Property: The property along North Main Street was identified by personnel familiar with the historical uses of the site as being a gasoline station and/or garage. Site conditions indicate the presence of an old concrete pad typical of service stations and garages and a former owner of the property claimed a pump island was present when he purchased the property. Records of the presence/absence of USTs at the property were not available. The potential for historical release has not been established.

A Phase II Environmental Assessment is recommended to provide information on soil and ground water quality in the areas of the collection pit and frontage road property. No further investigation is recommended for the hazardous waste storage shed or reported off-site violation at the Perry International Raceway.

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5.0 LIMITATIONS TO ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENTS

The findings contained in this report represent our professional opinions. These opinions were arrived at in accordance

with currently accepted industry practices and hydrological and engineering practices at this time and location are

subject to the current industry standard. Other than this, there are no warranties implied or intended.

5.1 Site Data Review

Delta obtained, reviewed, and evaluated information available from the client, and local, state, and federal offices.

Delta's conclusions, opinions, and recommendations are based, in part, on this information. Delta's services did not

include the verification of the authenticity of this information.

5.2 Site Reconnaissance

Delta performed a limited site reconnaissance to document current conditions. Delta focused on property areas deemed

more likely to exhibit hazardous materials and conditions while others may have received limited attention or had been

inaccessible at the time of our reconnaissance.

5.3 Interpretation of Results

Delta's report is based upon the information provided to Delta and Delta's observations made during the site

reconnaissance. Given the inherent limitations of environmental assessment work, Delta does not guarantee that the site
















FLOGD HAZARD BOUNDARY MAP H - OI




