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## 1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This Environmental Site Assessment was conducted for Mr. Kenneth Scott, Vice President, BSB Bank and Trust Co. (Syracuse Office) and Mr. John Feldmeier, President of Feldmeier Equipment, Inc.

The industrial property under review consists of two separate lots which are comprised of a total of approximately 6.5 acres and are located at 575 East Mill Street (occupied by Feldmeier Equipment) in the City of Little Falls, Herkimer County, New York. One lot, approximately 0.75 acres in size, is located on the north side of East Mill Street, and contains the boiler building for the facility and two small parking lots. The main facility is located on the south side of East Mill Street. Feldmeier Equipment manufactures pharmaceutical and food processing tanks at the subject property. The property has been used for numerous industrial purposes for more than 115 years. The current owner of the property (United Dominion Industries), doing business as Waukesha Cherry-Burrell, also manufactured tanks on-site for more than 50 years. Besides the manufacture of tanks, portions of the property have been used as a knitting mill, a tannery and a coal gasification plant. The most environmentally significant of these are believed to be the previous uses by the tannery and coal gasification plant.

A discussion regarding the findings of this site assessment relating to the potentially significant future environmental liabilities associated with the subject property appears in Section 6.0 of this report.

### Conclusions

1. Significant quantities of material which may contain asbestos, or are known to contain asbestos (floor tile and pipe insulation), are located in the main facility buildings. The presence of these materials represents a significant potential future environmental liability.
2. There are two aboveground 20,000-gallon fuel oil storage tanks and one empty aboveground 275 gallon kerosene tank located on the subject property. While the 20,000 gallon tanks are registered and have secondary containment, the 275 gallon tank is not currently registered with the NYSDEC. Any potential future environmental liability associated with the unregistered 275 gallon petroleum bulk storage tank is believed to be minor.
3. The previous use of the property by a tannery and coal gasification plant represents a significant potential future environmental liability. Properties used for these purposes are often sites of environmental concern to NYSDEC and the US Environmental Protection Agency. Many such sites are on the NYS Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal List and are in various stages of soil and/or groundwater remediation.

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Section 1 - Executive Summary (Con't)

**Recommendations**

1. In the event the materials known to contain asbestos, or that may contain asbestos, are to be disturbed or removed in the future, it is recommended that they be removed by a licensed asbestos abatement contractor.
2. It is recommended that the empty aboveground 275 gallon kerosene tank either be removed from the subject property or registered with the NYSDEC.
3. Due to the possible presence of solvents and petroleum contaminants in the soil and groundwater beneath the site, it is recommended that a limited subsurface investigation be performed at the site. The investigation should include several soil borings in the western portion of the property, where the coal gasification plant was previously located, to determine if coal tar waste or other contaminants are present beneath the site. In addition, 6-8 groundwater samples should be obtained from various locations around the property and analyzed for volatile organic contaminants.

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## **2.0 INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND**

The organization of this report is based on the format presented in ASTM E-1527-97 Standards on Environmental Site Assessments for Commercial Real Estate.

### **2.1 Purpose**

- A. Identify any known or potential non-compliance with local, State, or Federal environmental regulations at real property located at 575 East Mill Street in the City of Little Falls (Herkimer County), New York; and
- B. Make an assessment of the future potential environmental liability associated with the subject property.

### **2.2 Special Terms and Conditions**

Authorization to enter the subject property, to conduct a review of the property, including buildings and facilities, was received from Mr. John Feldmeier, President of Feldmeier Equipment, Inc.

### **2.3 Limitations and Exceptions of Assessment**

No subsurface investigations or testing of soil and/or groundwater from beneath the subject site were conducted as part of this site assessment. Also, no subsurface investigations (such as backhoe test pits, trenching, ground penetrating radar, or high resolution electromagnetic survey) were performed on the property to determine the presence or absence of underground storage tanks.

### **2.4 Methodology Used**

The assessment consisted of the following components:

- A. A historical review of the property based on a review of a tax map of the site; interviews with Mr. Darrell Swerdowski, a Region 6 NYSDEC representative (Watertown Office), Mr. John Spellman, NYSDEC Environmental Monitor for Niagara Mohawk Coal Tar sites, Mr. Edward Vogt, City of Little Falls Historian, and Mr. Jacob Haas III, a representative of Feldmeier Equipment; a review of the Little Falls USGS Quadrangle map dated 1943; and a review of several Sanborn maps of the property dated from 1884 to 1959.
- B. A visual review of the property was conducted to identify the possible presence of asbestos-containing materials, underground and aboveground storage tanks, hazardous waste storage containers, urea formaldehyde insulation, transformers that might contain PCB's, containers that might contain toxic materials, soil discolorations indicating possible chemical dumping, floor drains, drywells, or other circumstances requiring further review.

**2.4 Methodology Used (Con't)**

- C. A request to the New York State Department of Health (Herkimer Office), Environmental Health Division, was submitted for a records search for items of environmental significance regarding the subject property.
- D. The main building on the subject property was tested for the presence of radon.
- E. A review of numerous federal and state databases for sites with environmental problems at or near the property. The database search was performed by Environmental Risk Information & Imaging Services (ERIIS). The databases reviewed by ERIIS include the following:

  - New York Petroleum Bulk Storage Tanks (PBS)

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### **3.0 SITE DESCRIPTION**

#### **3.1 Location and Legal Description**

The subject property is approximately 6.5 acres in size and is located at 575 East Mill Street in the City of Little Falls (Herkimer County), New York.

A copy of the tax map of the subject property was reviewed as part of this site assessment. The tax map shows the boundaries and the length of each tax map parcel associated with the site. For clarity, the property has been divided into two lots (Lot No. 1 and Lot No. 2).

Lot No. 1 is approximately 0.75 acres in size and is comprised of tax map parcel numbers 115.61-1-75 and 115.61-1-76.

Lot No. 2, which extends from South William Street to opposite South Second Street, is approximately 5.75 acres in size and is comprised of tax map parcel numbers 115.61-1-86 to 91 and 115.61-1-93.

A copy of the tax map has been included in an appendix.

#### **3.2 Site and Vicinity Characteristics**

The property is located in the City of Little Falls along East Mill Street. The property consists of two lots; one lot is located along the north side of East Mill Street (Lot No. 1) and the other is located along the south side of East Mill Street (Lot No. 2). The land uses in the general area are primarily commercial and industrial properties.

There are several structures associated with the industrial operations on the subject property. These buildings are described in Section 3.3 below.

Lot No. 1 is bordered on the south by East Mill Street, on the north by railroad-owned property, on the east by a warehouse building, and on the west by industrial property (Vincent Farm Products Corporation). Lot No. 2, which contains the main facility buildings, is located across East Mill Street from Lot No. 1. The boiler building for the subject facility is located on Lot No. 1. In addition, there are two parking lots on this property which are located on the east and west sides of the boiler building.

Lot No. 2 is bordered on the north by East Mill Street, on the south by the Mohawk River, on the east by South Williams Street, and on the west by commercial property (George Lumber and Bldg. Materials). Lot No. 1, a trucking company, a warehouse, and industrial properties (Sunbelt Industries and Vincent Farm Products) are located across East Mill Street from Lot No. 2. There are several structures located on Lot No. 2 which are all connected. The structures include a 7-story unused building, and the office and tank manufacturing buildings. Parking areas are located on the east and west ends of the main facility building.

A copy of a tax map was reviewed as part of this site assessment and shows the property under review. The property is shown to be approximately 6.5 acres in size. The tax map shows the boundaries of the subject property. No other site specific information was shown on the survey map.

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Section 3 - Site Description (Con't)

**3.3 Description of Structures**

There are several structures on the subject property including the boiler building on Lot No. 1, a 7-story unused building, and the office and tank manufacturing buildings on Lot No. 2. The structures on Lot No. 2 are connected to one another from east to west across the property. The structures are described below:

The boiler building is believed to have been constructed in the 1940's for use as a heating plant for the Cherry-Burrell facility which began operations at 575 East Mill Street in the 1940's. This brick building contains the fuel oil-fired boiler for the facility as well as the necessary steam distribution piping. The boiler was originally coal-fired.

The building also contains numerous trench drains which reportedly convey condensate to the municipal sewer system.

The 7-Story Building which is attached to the east end of the main facility buildings was constructed in 1911 as part of tannery operations previously located on this portion of the property. The building, which is in very poor condition, is now vacant with the exception of scrap materials which are stored on the ground floor awaiting off-site disposal. An empty, aboveground 275 gallon kerosene tank (out of service) was observed in this storage area. The tank was provided with secondary spill containment. The remainder of the building was not accessible at the time of the site review.

The eastern and central portions of the four-story main facility buildings are used for offices, parts machining, conducting various processes associated with the tank manufacturing operations (i.e., pacivation and plasma cutting, etc.), and the storage of paints, solvents, hydraulic fluids, and hazardous waste. This building is believed to have been constructed in the 1920's.

The western portion of the main facility buildings is used for tank manufacturing and assembly operations, as well as other processes associated with the tank manufacturing operations (i.e., electropolishing and painting). The treatment of tank cleaning and electropolish process wastes prior to discharge into the municipal sewer system occurs in this portion of the building.

The old tank manufacturing structure was constructed in the 1950's. An addition to the west end of this building was constructed in 1990.

According to Mr. Haas, there are more than 125,000 sf of buildings on the subject property. All the buildings have been supplied with steam heat and utilize the municipal water and sewer systems (City of Little Falls).

The building was reviewed for materials that may contain asbestos. A description of these activities is located in Section 5.8 of this report.

**3.4 Information Reported by User Regarding Environmental Liens  
or Specialized Knowledge or Experience**

The preparer of this report and the operator of the facility have no knowledge of environmental liens that are associated with the subject property.

**3.5 Current Uses of Property**

The property is currently used by Feldmeier Equipment, Inc. for the manufacture of pharmaceutical and food processing tanks.

**3.6 Previous Uses of Property**

A historical review of the property based on a review of a tax map of the site; interviews with Mr. Darrell Swerdowski, a Region 6 NYSDEC representative (Watertown Office), Mr. John Spellman, NYSDEC Environmental Monitor for Niagara Mohawk Coal Tar sites, Mr. Edward Vogt, City of Little Falls Historian, and Mr. Jacob Haas III, a representative of Feldmeier Equipment; a review of the Little Falls USGS Quadrangle map dated 1943; and a review of several Sanborn maps of the property dated from 1884 to 1959.

The abstract of title was unavailable for review; therefore, previous uses of the subject property are primarily based on Sanborn maps.

Prior to its use as a parking lot and the facility heating plant, Lot No. 1 was used as a coal storage and distribution facility until the 1950's. A coal company operated for several years after the boiler building was constructed (before 1948) on what is now the parking area adjoining the north side of the boiler building.

According to the Sanborn maps, the following previous uses have occupied various portions of the property containing the main facility buildings:

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3.6 Previous Uses of Property (Con't)

The Sanborn maps indicated that a coal gasification plant was located on the western end of the property during the late-1800's until approximately 1920. The coal gasification company had several names over the years including Little Falls Gas Light Co., Herkimer County Light and Power Co., and the Utica Gas and Electric Company. Two gas storage containers, 50,000 gallons and 16,000 gallons in size, respectively, were located on this portion of the site. A customer service station was located on the property for several years after the plant operations were discontinued. It is not known if this portion of the property was used for the disposal of coal tar wastes.

Several knitting mills were located on the subject property including the Saxony Knitting Mill, Little Falls Fibre Co., and the Ablett MacKinnon & Co. Knitting Mill. The knitting mills were located on the western and central portions of the property. Numerous buildings were associated with these operations.

The central portion of the property, along East Mill street, was occupied by several residential structures until approximately 1920.

The central and eastern portions of the property were occupied for many years by a tannery (Gilbert & Weeks Tannery and J.S. Barnet & Bros. Tannery) and the J. Zoller Packing House. The buildings and facilities associated with these two companies included cattle sheds, a slaughter house, bark storage, hide storage, and tanning pits. The buildings on the eastern and central portions of the property, constructed by the tannery and packing house companies were configured similar to the way they appear today by 1930.

Cherry-Burrell is believed to have begun their tank manufacturing operations on the subject property approximately 50 years ago. All buildings previously associated with the coal gasification plant and knitting mills were removed from the western portion of the property during the 1950's by Cherry-Burrell to expand their facilities.

Mr. Vogt, City of Little Falls Historian, did not offer any specific information on the subject property.

The Little Falls USGS Quadrangle map does not show any specific site information other than the presence of numerous industrial buildings on the property in 1943.

**3.7 Current and Previous Uses of Adjoining Property**

The current uses of the properties adjoining the subject site are shown in Section 3.2 of this report.

Sanborn maps dating from 1884 to 1959 were reviewed for previous uses of adjoining properties. According to these maps, the railroad property, which adjoins the north side of Lot No. 1 (boiler building property), has been used as a railroad for more than 115 years.

The property adjoining the west side of Lot No. 2 was used for at least 65 years as a paper box factory. Around 1950, the buildings associated with the box factory were removed and the lot was used for parking.

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**Section 3 - Site Description (Con't)**

**3.7 Current and Previous Uses of Adjoining Property (Con't)**

The previous uses of the properties on the north side of East Mill Street, which include the properties adjoining the east and west sides of Lot No. 1, have included a knitting mill, a paper mill, a print shop, residences, and tannery factory product and raw materials storage.

The property east of South Williams Street was used for residential purposes prior to Burrows Paper Co. use of the property which is believed to have begun sometime in the 1930's.

No other previous uses of these properties were determined from this study.

**3.8 Site Plans and Location Map**

Copies of the location, tax, and Sanborn maps are located in an appendix.

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## 4.0 RECORDS REVIEW

### 4.1 Standard Environmental Record Sources (State and Federal)

The following state and federal databases were investigated for sites with environmental problems near the subject property:

According to the ERIIS database search list of plottable sites, there are no NPL, CERCLIS, ERNS, or RCRA-TSD sites located within the ASTM Minimum Search Distance from the property. However, eleven sites of environmental concern were identified within the ASTM Minimum Search Distance of the subject property including two listings for the subject property. The sites include five petroleum bulk storage facilities, one solid waste facility, one chemical bulk storage facility, one spill site, one No Further Remedial Action Planned (NFRAP) site, and two RCRA facilities. Cherry-Burrell was identified as a RCRA facility (EPA ID No. NYD981075963) and a petroleum bulk storage facility (two 20,000 gallon fuel oil tanks in service). The NFRAP site address is believed to be part of the subject property (545 East Mill Street). It is possible that a portion of the subject property was previously owned by the Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation as indicated by ERIIS; however, this was not confirmed during this study. Several other listings by ERIIS indicate that adjoining properties of concern including 525 East Mill Street ((now George Lumber and Building Materials as a former solid waste facility (SWF) and the Burrows Paper Corporation (CBS and PBS).

The ERIIS list of unplottable sites was also reviewed for sites that may be located within the ASTM Minimum Search Distance from the property and there is one listing for the Burrows Paper Corporation (RCRA).

A copy of the ERIIS study has been included in an appendix.

The NYSDEC Spill Response List was reviewed for nearby spill sites. There is one listing for the subject property (Spill No. 8905781). No. 6 fuel oil was spilled beneath the tanks located behind the boiler building. Approximately 12 cubic yards of fuel oil contaminated soil was excavated and disposed of off-site. At the conclusion of the soil disposal activities, this spill was closed.

There are numerous other spills located at properties within one-half mile of the subject; however, none of the spills is believed to adversely affect the groundwater beneath the subject site due to their containment, distance from the site, or location hydraulically downgradient or cross-gradient from the property.

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Section 4 - Records Review (Con't)

**4.2 Physical Setting Source**

According to the location map, a copy of a portion of the Little Falls USGS Quadrangle map, the site is at an average elevation of approximately 360 feet above mean sea level. According to the map, the topography in the general area is gently to moderately sloping in a north to south direction toward the Mohawk River which is located adjacent to the subject property. The property is shown on the map to be at 43°02'30" latitude and 74°52' longitude.

**4.3 Historical Use Information**

Previous uses of the property are shown in Section 3.6 of this report.

No historical information found during the preparation of this report indicates that the site has been used for purposes other than those listed in Section 3.6 of this report.

**4.4 Additional Record Sources**

A. New York State Department of Health (Herkimer Office)

Mr. Gregory Rys, a representative of the New York State Department of Health (Herkimer Office), was contacted regarding the subject property. He indicated that his office had no responsive data relative to the subject property. A copy of the response letter from the NYSDOH has been included in an appendix.

B. New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Albany Office)

Mr. John Spellman, Environmental Engineer and Monitor for Niagara Mohawk Coal Tar Remediation Sites for the NYSDEC, was contacted regarding known coal gasification and coal tar disposal sites located in Little Falls. Mr. Spellman indicated that he knew of no such sites in Little Falls and to his knowledge, Niagara Mohawk has not notified the NYSDEC of the existence of any coal gasification/coal tar disposal sites previously owned or operated by Niagara Mohawk in Little Falls. He indicated that there are currently 23 Niagara Mohawk former coal gasification/coal tar disposal sites located in New York State. In addition, he stated that there are 33 New York State Electric and Gas (NYSEG) coal tar clean-up sites in the state. Mr. Spellman said that most of these sites are at various stages of investigation. He said that coal tar sites are of particular concern due to the possible presence of benzene, polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbon, and volatile and semi-volatile compounds in the groundwater beneath these properties. None of the coal tar sites which Mr. Spellman is aware of have been completely remediated to date.

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## **5.0 INFORMATION FROM SITE RECONNAISSANCE AND INTERVIEWS**

### **5.1 Hazardous Substances in Connection with Identified Uses**

EPA Hazardous Waste Generator number NYD981075963 was assigned to the subject facility. Hazardous wastes generated at the facility originate from parts machining and tank painting operations. Several locations in the main facility building were observed to be labeled as hazardous waste storage areas. Many of the individual 55 gallon drums containing hazardous waste were provided with secondary containment and were stored in good order. Hazardous waste is removed from the property on a regular basis by Safety Kleen Corp. Copies of several hazardous waste manifests were reviewed and have been included in an appendix.

### **5.2 Hazardous Substance Containers and Unidentified Substance Containers**

Several hazardous substance containers (55 gallon drums) were observed at various locations in the main facility building. These drums were located in the hazardous waste storage areas and also in the paint storage room. These drums primarily included paint thinner, mineral spirits, cutting oil, and lubrication oil. Hazardous substance containers were observed to be stored in good order.

### **5.3 Storage Tanks**

Three petroleum bulk storage tanks were observed at the subject facility with two currently registered with NYSDEC for the subject facility. Two 20,000 gallon aboveground fuel oil tanks are located on the north side of the boiler building. These tanks have been provided with secondary spill containment and no evidence of fuel spillage was observed near these tanks. One empty 275 gallon kerosene tank was observed on the first floor of the vacant seven story building. This tank is not currently in service although it has been provided with secondary spill containment. This tank has not been registered with NYSDEC. A copy of the NYSDEC tank registration form for the subject facility has been included in an appendix.

No other storage tanks were observed on the property.

### **5.4 Indications of PCBs**

Several electrical transformers were observed in the main facility building which are labeled as containing PCB oil. Each transformer was observed to be provided with secondary spill containment.

### **5.5 Indications of Solid Waste Disposal**

No evidence was observed that the site is currently being used for the disposal of solid waste. As indicated in Section 3.6 of this report, historical uses of portions of the property include a tannery and a coal gasification plant. These industries may have used portions of the property for the disposal of solid waste. However, there is no evidence that the subject property has been used as a community wide solid waste disposal facility.

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Section 5 - Information From Site Reconnaissance And Interviews (Con't)

**5.6 Radon**

The main building was tested for the presence of radon. According to the Site Radon Inspection Report, the radon level in the subject building is 0.5 pCi/L, which is below the USEPA recommended "action level" of 4 pCi/L for occupied spaces. A copy of the radon report has been included in an appendix.

**5.7 Air Emissions**

There are three NYSDEC air emission permits for the subject facility. These permits are associated with emissions from the facility boiler and the tank spray painting booth. Copies of the permits have been included in an appendix.

**5.8 Asbestos**

The subject facility was reviewed for the presence of asbestos-containing materials. Materials observed that may contain asbestos include vinyl floor tile, acoustical ceiling tile, and pipe insulation. Mr. Jacob Haas III reported that Lozier Architects/Engineers performed an asbestos survey in the buildings on the subject property in 1993 and performed asbestos abatement activities in the boiler building. A copy of the Plans and Specifications prepared by Lozier for the Asbestos Abatement and Management Project (dated December 1993) was reviewed as part of this site assessment. The plans indicate that asbestos pipe and boiler insulation has been removed from the boiler building; however, significant quantities of asbestos pipe insulation and vinyl asbestos floor tile remains in the main facility building.

It should be noted that the review conducted of the building for potential sources of asbestos does not constitute a full asbestos inspection and additional sources of asbestos may be present. Recommendations regarding sampling and analysis of potential sources of asbestos are located in Section 8.0.

**5.9 Wastewater**

Wastewater generated at the subject facility is discharged to the Little Falls Wastewater Treatment Plant. Sanitary sewer wastes are untreated prior to discharge to the treatment plant; however, industrial wastes from metal finishing operations are subject to an industrial pre-treatment permit issued to the facility. Metal finishing operations subject to the permit include cleaning, grinding, polishing, and welding.

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## 6.0 DISCUSSION OF ENVIRONMENTALLY SIGNIFICANT FINDINGS

Several items of environmental concern were discovered at the subject facility that are related to asbestos-containing materials, the presence of an unregistered petroleum bulk storage tank on the property, and the previous use of the property by a tannery and coal gasification plant.

- Several materials in the building were observed that may contain asbestos or are known to contain asbestos. These materials include vinyl floor tile (non-friable) and pipe insulation (friable). Lozier Architects and Engineers performed an asbestos survey of the property in 1993 and identified several hundred lineal feet of asbestos-containing pipe insulation and several thousand square feet of asbestos floor tile. According to Mr. Haas, an asbestos abatement project was performed on the boiler building in 1995.

New York State regulates asbestos under NYSDOL Code Rule 56 which stipulates removal methods, public notice, and the use of NYSDOL licensed personnel for repair or removal. OSHA 29 CFR 1926.58 stipulates that owners of buildings must notify all workers and tradespeople of the presence of asbestos-containing materials. Friable asbestos-containing materials are generally viewed with greater concern than non-friable asbestos because of the greater likelihood of asbestos fibers becoming airborne from damaged friable material.

Although removal of the pipe insulation is not required at this time, the presence of this material represents a significant potential future environmental liability. Recommendations regarding sampling and analysis of this material for asbestos content are shown in Section 8.0.

Any potential future environmental liability associated with the remaining non-friable materials is believed to be relatively minor.

- There are two aboveground 20,000-gallon fuel oil storage tanks and one empty aboveground 275 gallon kerosene tank located on the subject property. While the 20,000 gallon tanks are registered and have secondary containment, the 275 gallon tank is not currently registered with the NYSDEC. Any potential future environmental liability associated with the unregistered 275 gallon petroleum bulk storage tank is believed to be minor.
- Section 3.6 of this report indicates that the property has been used for industrial purposes for more than 115 years. Numerous Sanborn maps were reviewed for the previous occupants of the property and the locations and uses of previous buildings on-site. The maps indicate that the property has been occupied by several industries since 1884 including knitting mills, a tannery, and a coal gasification plant. Former tannery and coal gasification plant sites typically appear on the NYS Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal list due to soil and groundwater contamination often present beneath these locations. Former coal gasification plant sites are of particular concern due to the possible presence of benzene, polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbon, and volatile and semi-volatile compounds in the groundwater beneath these properties. Coal tar waste was also often disposed on these properties. It is possible that the previous use of portions of the subject property by a tannery and coal gasification plant has caused significant soil and groundwater contamination beneath the site. The previous use of this property by a tannery and coal gasification plant represents a significant potential environmental liability.

## 7.0 CONCLUSIONS

The following conclusions were reached as a result of this site assessment:

1. Significant quantities of material which may contain asbestos, or are known to contain asbestos (floor tile and pipe insulation), are located in the main facility buildings. The presence of these materials represents a significant potential future environmental liability.
2. There are two aboveground 20,000-gallon fuel oil storage tanks and one empty aboveground 275 gallon kerosene tank located on the subject property. While the 20,000 gallon tanks are registered and have secondary containment, the 275 gallon tank is not currently registered with the NYSDEC. Any potential future environmental liability associated with the unregistered 275 gallon petroleum bulk storage tank is believed to be minor.
3. The previous use of the property by a tannery and coal gasification plant represents a significant potential future environmental liability. Properties used for these purposes are often sites of environmental concern to NYSDEC and the US Environmental Protection Agency. Many such sites are on the NYS Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal List and are in various stages of soil and/or groundwater remediation.

## 8.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

1. In the event the materials known to contain asbestos, or that may contain asbestos, are to be disturbed or removed in the future, it is recommended that they be removed by a licensed asbestos abatement contractor.
2. It is recommended that the empty aboveground 275 gallon kerosene tank either be removed from the subject property or registered with the NYSDEC.
3. Due to the possible presence of solvents and petroleum contaminants in the soil and groundwater beneath the site, it is recommended that a limited subsurface investigation be performed at the site. The investigation should include several soil borings in the western portion of the property, where the coal gasification plant was previously located, to determine if coal tar waste or other contaminants are present beneath the site. In addition, 6-8 groundwater samples should be obtained from various locations around the property and analyzed for volatile organic contaminants.


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


Herkimer and Little Falls USGS Quadrangle Maps




Photograph of the north side of the main facility building,




Photograph of the northwest portion of the north side of the main facility building, taken looking west. February 3, 1998.








Photograph of the south side of the boiler building,

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




Photograph of parking area east of boiler building,  
taken looking northeast. February 3, 1998.

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


Photograph of typical transformer containing PCB oil located in the main facility building. February 3, 1998.

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


Photograph of fuel oil tanks located north of boiler building.




Photograph of empty and disconnected 275 gallon kerosene tank located in 7-story building adjoining main facility building. February 3, 1998.
