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Monthly Progress Report

1.0 Introduction

The following documents the progress related to the Voluntary Cleanup Action at the Coral Graphics warehouse facility located at 327 New South Road in Hicksville, New York during the month of December, 2002. This report will summarize all field activities conducted, analytical results, regulatory agency interactions and upcoming investigative or reporting activities.

2.0 Field Activities

A Ground Penetrating Radar Survey (GPR) survey was conducted at the above referenced site on December 17, 2002. The survey was conducted at the request of the NYSDEC and NCDHS to determine the location of overflow stormwater leaching pools connected to the three (3) surface stormwater drywells located on the subject property. Results of this survey identified four (4) anomalies located partially or entirely on the adjacent property immediately east of the study site. As part of the investigation the NYSDEC has required that these locations be investigated further to determine if they are overflow pools and if so to collect sediment samples for laboratory analysis from the bottom of each structure. Prior to any investigative activities access approval from the adjacent property owner will be required to gain access to the property. Presently, attempts are being made to receive site access approval.

3.0 Analytical Results

No analytical results were received during the month of December, 2002.

4.0 Upcoming Activities

Upcoming activities yet to be scheduled include further investigation and possible sampling at the anomaly locations detected during the GPR survey. In addition, the NYSDEC has requested that we begin tank removal activities related to the partially abandoned 3,000 gallon underground storage tank located south of the facility building.
