The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (the "Department") has j_4 received the letter dated January 22, 2010 and the accompanying letters dated January 19, 2010: Hiscock & Barclay LLP Request to Terminate Declarations of Covenants and Restrictions and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. Request to Terminate and certification.

The Department has determined that the remedial objectives set forth in the March 2002 Record of Decision have been met; the remediation has been satisfactorily completed; and the existing conditions, including groundwater meeting applicable groundwater quality standards, are protective of public health and the environment for unrestricted use of the land without the implementation of institutional or engineering controls. Therefore, the Department consents to the termination of the Declaration and First Amended Declaration referenced above.

Annual Certifications and Periodic Review Reports are no longer required for this property.
