DOREEN A. SIMMONS, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

- 1. I am an attorney at law admitted to practice before the courts of the State of New York, and a member of the firm of Hancock Estabrook, LLP which firm maintains offices for the practice of law at 100 Madison Street, AXA Tower I, 15th Floor, Syracuse, New York, 13202.
- 2. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) and Wyoming County will require limited access to property owned by Ms. Ann M. Wielgosz located at 3718 Wethersfield Road, Wethersfield, New York (hereinafter "Property") as outlined in my letter to Ms. Wielgosz of April 16, 2013, the annexed April 9, 2013 Notice letter of the Wyoming County Board of Supervisors referenced therein [Exhibit 1], and shown on the attached Groundwater Elevation Contour Map [Exhibit 2], as follows:
- a. minimal annual access to the property for an inspection of the integrity of the permeable reactive wall; and
- b. semi-annual access to the property in the spring and summer for groundwater sampling.
- 3. The Property was transferred by deed to Ms. Wielgosz on March 3, 2008 and filed in the Wyoming County Clerk's Office at Book 722 Page 749.
- 4. This prohibition of remedy interference and the limited access which may be required from time-to-time are due to the implementation of a Site Management Plan [Exhibit 3]

related to the Wyoming County Fire Training Center Site (VCP Site # V00604) on Wethersfield Road which is in proximity to the Property.

5. The attached notice letters were forwarded to the Property owner and this affidavit has been prepared at the request of the NYSDEC.

This correspondence should be provided to any subsequent purchaser.

Further, information concerning the Site is available at the document repository or you may contact the NYSDEC.


