The following facility has failed to renew coverage under the State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) Multi-Sector General Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Industrial Activity (GP-0-23-001):

R.J. WILLIAMS, INC. 3716 STATE ROUTE 434 APALACHIN, NY 13732

In April 2023 you were sent a notice informing you that GP-0-17-004 had expired and that to maintain coverage under the new permit (GP-0-23-001), you were required to submit a new Notice of Intent (NOI) by June 8, 2023. To date, a completed NOI has not been received for this facility.

Discharging stormwater associated with industrial activities and/or making or operating a point source without a SPDES permit is a violation of Article 17 of the New York State Environmental Conservation Law (ECL). Violations of the ECL can incur significant financial penalties of up to \$37,500 per day per violation. In addition, it may violate the Federal Clean Water Act and United States Environmental Protection Agency regulations.
