### IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL PERMITTEES

The requested transfer has been issued. Enclosed is the corresponding "Application for Permit Transfer" executed by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC), a copy of the most recent administrative renewal (effective 8/27/20), a copy of the Department-initiated modification (issued 4/15/04) which contains updated requirements for 6 NYCRR 750-2, and copy of the most recent permit (issued 3/11/86) containing effluent limits. A copy of this approval must be attached to the referenced permit. The DEC permit number & program ID number (if applicable) which are noted on the transfer form are important and should be retained for your records. These numbers should be referenced on all correspondence related to the permit, and on any future applications for permits associated with this facility/project area.

Please review all permit conditions carefully, including any monitoring requirements and/or compliance schedules that may be required. In particular, identify your initial responsibilities under the permit in order to assure timely action and avoid late reporting if required. Since failure to comply precisely with permit conditions may be treated as a violation of the Environmental Conservation Law, you are requested to provide a copy of the permit to the project contractor, facility operator, and other persons directly responsible for permit implementation.

Please note the expiration date of the permit. Applications for renewal of the following permits must be submitted to the Regional Permit Administrator:

- 180 days or more prior to the expiration date for Major Air Pollution Control, Solid Waste, and Hazardous Waste Permits; or
- 30 days or more prior to the expiration date for all other operational permits, except SPDES.

Applications for renewal submitted to the Regional Permit Administrator must be sent via electronic copy to [dep.r3@dec.ny.gov](mailto:dep.r3@dec.ny.gov), and one hard copy set mailed to the above address.

Application for renewal of SPDES permit must be submitted on forms prescribed by the department and sent both via hard copy to the Chief Permit Administrator, Division of Environmental Permits, 625 Broadway, Albany, NY 12233-1750, and via electronic copy via [deppermitting@dec.ny.gov](mailto:deppermitting@dec.ny.gov). Renewal applications must be submitted 180 days or more prior to the expiration date.

DEC encourages the regulated community to utilize both environmental compliance audits and environmental management systems to ensure all environmental compliance requirements are satisfied. If this permit transfer involves an ownership change, DEC has special terms that allow you to disclose violations you discover during the course of acquiring the new facility. If you satisfy the terms contained in the new owner's provision (Section V.J) of DEC's Environmental Audit Incentive Policy, you will be eligible to disclose and correct discovered violations. In most instances penalties can be completely waived. Please refer to the DEC website at <https://www.dec.ny.gov/regulations/93791.html> for more information on how to take advantage of these special incentives for new owners.



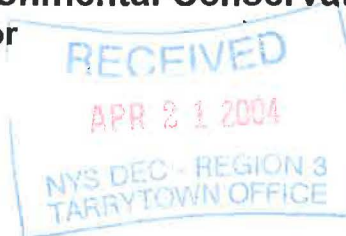

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify you of a Department initiated modification to the above-referenced State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) permit. This modification is undertaken in accordance with the provisions of the Uniform Procedures Act [6 NYCRR 621.14(a)(4)] and is due to the amendment of the existing regulation governing the administration of SPDES permits (6 NYCRR 750). The amendments incorporate provisions of the 'Part II General Conditions' supplement that serves as an additional set of conditional requirements to your SPDES permit. These amendments may be found in the enclosed copy of 6 NYCRR 750 in Section 750-2, entitled 'Operating in Accordance with a SPDES Permit.' You may also access this regulation from the internet on the Department's website at <http://www.dec.state.ny.us/website/regs/750.htm> for html format or <http://www.dec.state.ny.us/website/dow/part750.pdf> for a two sided format suitable for binding and copying.

The amendment of 6 NYCRR 750 duplicates many of the provisions of the 'Part II General Conditions' supplement, and includes some revisions and additions to those conditions. The Department initiated modification to your permit deletes the 'Part II General Conditions' and all references to them from your permit, and further amends the permit requiring you to comply with 6 NYCRR 750-2. The specific language of the modification is contained in the attached modification page that is to be appended to your existing permit.

The Department's Uniform Procedures Act affords permittees the right to comment on Department initiated permit changes [6 NYCRR 621.14(d)]. After reviewing the content of 6 NYCRR 750-2 and its effect on your SPDES permit, should you have any objections to the permit modification, you may submit a written statement to the Department giving reasons why the permit should not be modified, request a hearing, or both. Any statement or request for hearing must be made within 15 calendar days of the mailing of this letter. Failure to submit a timely request or statement will result in the modification of your permit, becoming effective May 01, 2004.

Where less than daily sampling is required by this permit, the daily average discharge shall be determined by the summation of all the measured daily discharges in appropriate units as specified herein divided by the number of days during the calendar month when the measurements were made.

The daily maximum discharge means the total discharge by weight or in other appropriate units as specified herein, during any calendar day.

- c) If so directed, Monthly Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator's Reports should be submitted to the Regional Engineer and County Health Department or County Environmental Control Agency specified above.
- d) Monitoring must be conducted according to test procedures approved under 40 CFR Part 136, unless other test procedures have been specified in this permit.
- e) If the permittee monitors any pollutant more frequently than required by the permit, using test procedures approved under 40 CFR 136 or as specified in the permit, the results of this monitoring shall be included in the calculations and recording of the data on the Discharge Monitoring Reports.
- f) Calculations for all limitations which require averaging of measurements shall utilize an arithmetic mean unless otherwise specified in this permit.
- g) Unless otherwise specified, all information recorded on the Discharge Monitoring Report shall be based upon measurements and sampling carried out during the most recently completed reporting period.
- h) On or after April 1, 1984, any laboratory test or sample analysis required by this permit for which the State Commissioner of Health issues certificates of approval pursuant to section five hundred two of the Public Health Law shall be conducted by a laboratory which has been issued a certificate of approval.
