When you recycle, you are protecting the environment and saving natural resources. Lots of items are made from recycled materials—things you use every day.

Here's a list of some of them:

Made from recycled plastics: rugs, lumber, clothes, garbage bags, sleeping bags, backyard decking, recycling bins, binders and more!

Made from recycled metals (aluminum and tin): soda cans, food cans, cookie sheets, mail boxes, license plates, cars, refrigerators and more!

Made from recycled glass: insulation, glass bottles, glassphalt and more!

Made from recycled paper: toilet paper, paper towels, napkins, greeting cards, newspapers, grocery bags, cereal boxes, ceiling tiles, wrapping paper, telephone books, copy paper, index cards and much more!
