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TRANSFER OF ELIGIBILITY

Environmental Conservation Law (ECL) 13-0328 (6)(a) gives DEC the authority to allow the reissuance of a license or permit to a member of the immediate family of the original license or permit holder. **6 NYCRR Part 40** allows the one-time reissuance of the commercial striped bass and commercial summer flounder permits in accordance with the provisions of **ECL 13-0328 (6)(a)**.

The following conditions must be met for the reissuance of the license or permit to the intended recipient to be valid and in effect:

1. The intended recipient of the license or permit must be an **immediate family member** of the license or permit holder. An immediate family member is a husband or wife (spouse), brother or sister (sibling), parent, child, grandparent, grandchild, and, in addition, all persons who are related by blood, marriage or adoption to the license or permit holder **AND** domiciled in the house of the license or permit holder.
2. The designated recipient must be at least 16 years of age.

This Transfer of Eligibility Form will allow a license or permit holder to identify an immediate family member to be the recipient of the reissued license or permit and to specify each license or permit to be reissued. This form must be signed and notarized on the back. This transfer will be able to take place upon submittal of this form to DEC. The intended recipient must apply for and pay the fee for the transferred license or permit.
