Description & Justification:

Cutting of approximately 15 trees to facilitate conduit and electric service line installation for the wax cabins in Parking Lot 1. Wax cabins are necessary for the 2023 World University Games. The 2018 UMP Amendment for Mount Van Hoevenberg approved these temporary and moveable structures. Language is included within this application and can be found in Section 4, Page 10 of the UMP. These wax cabins require heat, lights and working to entirely eliminate generators and their environmental liabilities, the goal of this project is to service the main panel from the sectionalizer in Parking Lot 2, then distribute power from the panel to the temporary location of the wax cabins as needed.

Materials and Dimensions:

Electric service line, conduit installation approximately 100 feet long between existing parking lots 1 and 2.
