Project will be covered under 2022 SWPPP for Whiteface Mountain, under development. Generally, cut and grub, seed and mulch disturbed areas, management of all SWPPP controls until final stabilization.

None. No work occurring above 2800 feet.

All activity below 2800 feet and outside protected habitat areas. Blasting will occur to achieve desired grade.





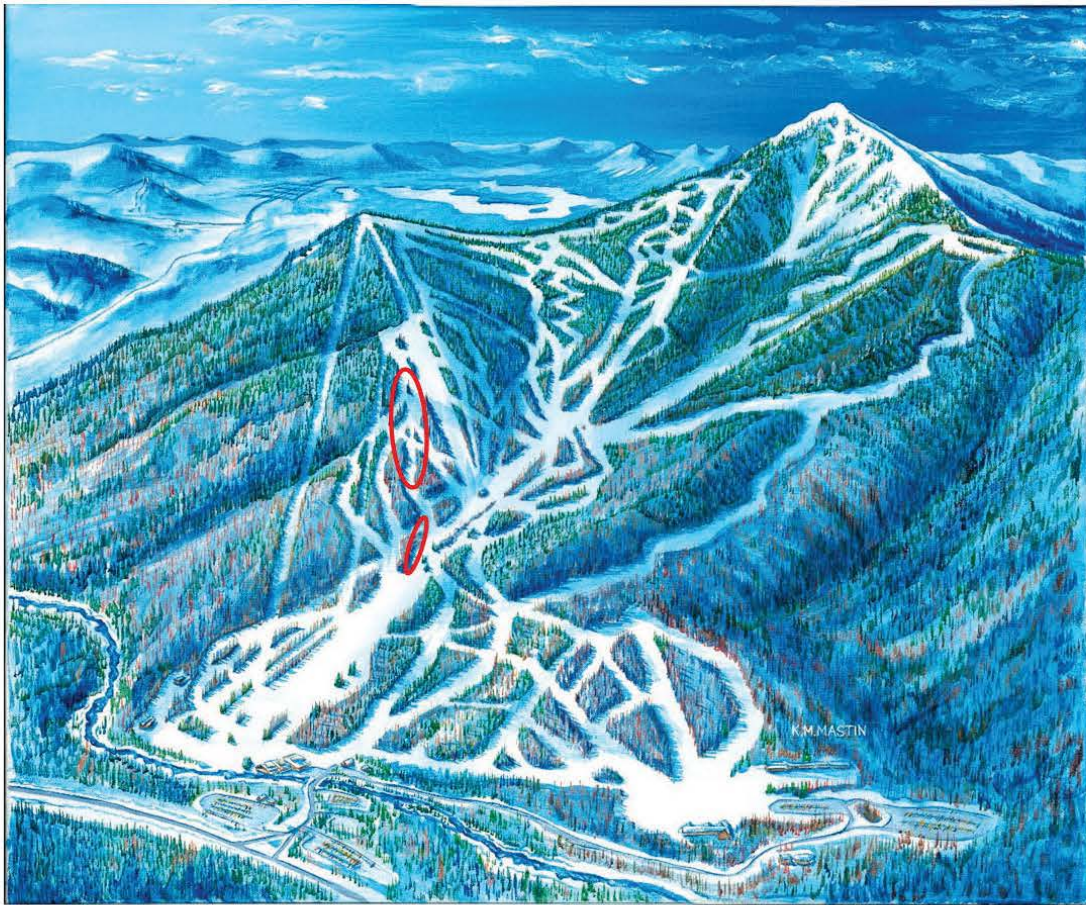
