This facility also operates surface impoundments, tank systems and container storage areas for waste storage and treatment.

CWM is proposing to construct and operate a new landfill (RMU-2) which would occupy approximately 43.5 acres and would be located within the central portion of its existing facility. It has a designed capacity of approximately 4,030,700 cubic yards for the disposal of hazardous and industrial non-hazardous wastes.
