WHEREAS, the County has enacted Local Law No. 1 of 1989 requiring municipalities within the County to source separate, recycle and dispose of solid waste upon notification of this Board; and

WHEREAS, Resolution Nos. 89 and 105 of 1989 directed certain towns and villages within the County to comply with Local Law No. 1 of 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Northern Transfer Station and Recycling Facility, located north of the Village of Cooperstown, became operational on December 4, 1989; and

WHEREAS, this Board now determines that the following municipalities should be notified pursuant to Section 12 of said Local Law to commence compliance effective February 15, 1990; said towns and villages being the Town of Cherry Valley, Town of Exeter, Town of Hartwick, Town of Middlefield, Town of Otsego, Town of Plainfield, Town of Richfield, Town of Roseboom, Town of Springfield, Village of Cherry Valley, Village of Cooperstown, Village of Milford and Village of Richfield Springs; said recyclable, source separated and solid waste materials pursuant to Local Law No. 1 of 1989 to be directed to the Northern Transfer Station and Recycling Center; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Board of Representatives, pursuant to Section 12 of Local Law No. 1 of 1989, directs the aforementioned towns and villages of the County to implement the above Local Law commencing February 15, 1990, directing all recyclable, source separated and solid waste materials generated within the

municipalities to the Northern Transfer Station and Recycling Facility; and be it further
RESOLVED, that the Clerk of this Board is directed to transmit copies of this resolution to Supervisors, Town Boards, Mayors and Village Boards of Trustees of each of the above named municipalities immediately upon adoption of this resolution.

WHEREAS the County has recently enacted Local Law No. 1 of 1989 requiring municipalities within the County to source separate, recycle and dispose of solid waste to designated locations within the County, upon notification of this Board; and

WHEREAS this Board now determines that the following municipalities should be notified pursuant to Section 12 of said Local Law to commence compliance, effective June 1, 1989; said towns being Edmeston, Burlington, Pittsfield, New Lisbon, Morris, Butternuts, Laurens, Milford, Maryland, Westford, Decatur, Worcester, Oneonta, and City of Oneonta and the Villages of Gilbertsville, Laurens, Milford, Morris and Schenevus; said recyclable, source separated and solid waste materials pursuant to the Local Law No. 1 of 1989 to be directed to the Southern Otsego County-City of Oneonta Transfer Station; and

WHEREAS, this Board has heretofore adopted Resolution No. 89 of 1989 providing this notification and the purpose of this resolution is to clarify that the notice shall include notice to the villages located within each of the aforementioned townships; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Board of Representatives, pursuant to Section 12 of Local Law No. 1 of 1989 directs the following towns of the County to implement the above Local Law commencing June 1, 1989, directing all recyclable, source separated and solid waste materials generated within the municipalities to the Southern Otsego County-City of Oneonta Transfer and Recycling Station: Towns of Edmeston, Burlington, Pittsfield, New Lisbon,

Morris, Butternuts, Laurens, Milford, Maryland, Westford,
Decatur, Worcester, Oneonta and the City of Oneonta, and the
Villages of Gilbertsville, Laurens, Milford, Morris and
Schenvus.



RESOLUTION - AMENDING RESOLUTION
NOS. 89 AND 105 OF 1989

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 89 and Resolution No. 105 of 1989 directed certain towns and villages in Otsego County to comply with Local Law No. 1 of 1989 regarding recycling, source separation and disposal of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, the Towns of Otego and Unadilla and the Villages of Otego and Unadilla, at that time, were members of the BAGS Sanitary Landfill District; and

WHEREAS, said BAGS Sanitary Landfill District has ceased accepting waste from the members of said District on or about November 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Towns of Otego and Unadilla and Villages of Otego and Unadilla have been using the Southern Transfer Station and Recycling Center in Oneonta since the above BAGS Sanitary Landfill closure on November 1, 1989; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that all recyclables, source separated material and solid waste generated within the aforementioned municipalities are hereby directed to the Southern Transfer Station and Recycling Center in Oneonta; additional notice prior to implementation by this resolution is not being provided recognizing that these municipalities have, by the necessity of the closure of the BAGS Sanitary Landfill District, been voluntarily utilizing the Southern Transfer Station and Recycling Center since November 1, 1989; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town of Otego, the Town of Unadilla, the Village of Otego, and the Village of Unadilla are hereby directed, pursuant to Section 12 of Local Law No. 1 of 1989 to commence compliance and implementation of said Local Law

effective immediately upon receipt of this notification by the Clerk of this Board as hereinafter provided; and be it further
RESOLVED, that the Clerk of this Board is directed to
transmit copies of this resolution to the appropriate
Supervisors, Town Boards, Mayors and Village Boards of Trustees
of each of the above named municipalities immediately upon
adoption of this resolution.

RESOLUTION NO. 323

RESOLUTION - FURTHER DEFINING
SUITABLE CONTAINERS AND RECYCLABLE
MATERIALS PURSUANT TO LOCAL LAW NO.
1 OF 1989 (SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND
SOURCE SEPARATION OF RECYCLABLES)

WHEREAS, this Board adopted Local Law No. 1 of 1989 (A Local Law Authorized by Section 120-aa GML Requiring for all Solid Waste within the County of Otsego, Source Separation and Segregation of Recyclable or Reusable Materials), and this Local Law provided that this Board may, by resolution, further define and classify various materials as recyclable and the types of containers deemed suitable for solid waste disposal and separation of recyclable materials; and

WHEREAS, this Board now deems it appropriate to require use of "clear plastic bags" as suitable containers as prescribed by the above Local Law for solid waste disposal and source separation of recyclable materials; further that cardboard and "squeezable plastic" be deemed a recyclable material as defined by Section 3, No. 9 of said Local Law; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Board does declare that effective February 15, 1990, "clear plastic bags" shall be deemed the sole suitable container for disposal of solid waste and recyclable materials within the County of Otsego as such term "suitable containers" is defined within Local Law No. 1 of 1989; further, effective the same date, recyclable materials, as defined by Section 3, No. 9 of said Local Law, shall include additionally, cardboard and "squeezable plastic".

This Board encourages the general public to utilize "clear plastic bags" and source separate "squeezable plastic" and cardboard immediately, if at all possible, prior to the effective date of this resolution, namely, February 15, 1990.
