The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) has completed the review of the Minor Permit Modification request received on February 21, 2017 to update the Form 8700-12 Section A to check "Y" (Yes) for item 5 and Transfer Facility (sub section b.). After meeting with Norlite on the use of the Cohoes Facility as a 10 day exempt transfer facility exempt from permitting under 373-1.1(d)(1)(xv) it was determined that those activities would be conducted under the Transporter Identification number of Tradebe, and will not require an update to Norlite's Form 8700-12. The Department will not take any further action for this modification request.

The Department appreciates the opportunity to meet with Norlite and Tradebe staff concerning the use of the Cohoes facility for 10 day exempt transfer activities. We request that Norlite/Tradebe provide the Department a proposal on the manner in which these 10 day permit exempt activities will take place, along with any drawing which will demonstrate how the requirements of 372.3(a)(7)(iii) will be met for secondary containment for the transfer activities described during our site visit on May 31, 2017.
