LAND CLEARING DEBRIS LANDFILL

A Land Clearing Debris Landfill is a landfill that is three acres of less used for the <u>disposal</u> of only vegetative matter, soil and rock resulting from activities such as land clearing and grubbing, utility line maintenance or seasonal or storm-related cleanup such as trees, stumps, brush and leaves and including wood chips generated from these materials.
