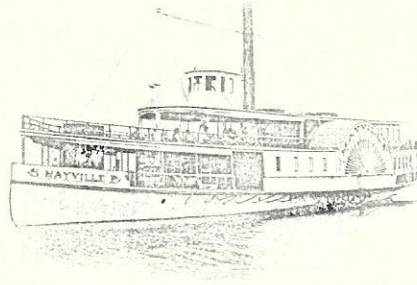

Please find the annual reports for calendar year 2020 enclosed and in order.

The Mayville Transfer Station is a facility that is operated by the Village of Mayville and Town of Chautauqua. Recyclable materials are accepted from 6,500-residents in the Village and Town on Fridays and Saturdays. Municipal Solid Waste (garbage & trash) is only accepted from Village residents, additionally curbside collection is provided one day per week to Village residents.

The municipal solid waste we haul to the Chautauqua County Landfill for disposal and the recyclables materials we haul to various private transporters in Chautauqua County.
